PLAYER FEE & FUNDRAISER

Families choose between buyout option and fundraiser (selling candy bars) option.

Player fee/buyout fee is due at time of registration. Candy money does not need to be turned in until May 1st

Please make checks payable to Fondy Youth Baseball.

Grades 4K – 2nd Leagues –Player fee of \$65.00 PLUS one of the options below:

- Sell 1 box of candy (40 bars sold for \$2 each) = \$80.00 (Must attend in-person registration night to pick up candy)
- Choose Buyout and sell no candy bars: \$30.00 in addition to player fee = \$95.00

Grades 3rd – 6th Leagues – Player fee of \$80.00 PLUS one of the options below:

- Sell 1 box of candy (40 bars sold for \$2 each) = \$80.00 (Must attend in-person registration night to pick up candy)
- Choose Buyout and sell no candy bars: \$70.00 in addition to player fee = \$150.00

***Grades 7th -12^{th} - Player fee of \$100.00 PLUS one of the options below:

- Sell 2 boxes of candy (80 bars sold for \$2 each) = \$160.00 (Must attend in-person registration night to pick up candy)
- Choose Buyout and sell no candy bars: \$100.00 in addition to player fee = \$200.00

*** 7th-12th Grade InfoDue to player numbers in 7th grade and older we have not been able to offer a local rec league the past 2 years. We do hope to in the future if numbers allow. If not, we have given players the option of playing in a Fox Valley League against other rec teams from Oshkosh to Appleton with 7 home games and 7 road games. Those decisions are made by our board after registration. If a player registers and there is not enough for a local league and they do not want to play in Fox Valley League, we would refund their money. Please register early so we can plan as if you don't like the options we will refund your money

NOTES:

- If you have three or more children participating in Youth Baseball, the youngest child does not have to participate in the fundraiser/buyout and only pays the league fee.

REGISTRATION OPTIONS

*** For all registrations, player families will need to remember their sports engine account and password from last year. This would be the same account being used with other FDL youth sports. If you do not have one, simply create an account.

*** Registration directions and help can always be found on our web site at www.fdlyouthbaseball.com.

- 1) Complete all registration from home- Go to <u>www.fdlyouthbaseball.com</u> and click on registration after February 1st-Log in and follow registration options. Select buyout (no fundraising option). Can pay by credit card on-line, pay off-line by coming to in-person registration (print registration) or pay off-line by mailing check made out to Fondy Youth Baseball to PO Box 1131, Fond du Lac, WI 54936. Check must be received before February 26th to avoid late fee.
- 2) Do all registration at home but select fundraising option to sell candy. Candy bars must be picked up at one of the inperson registration times listed on front of this sheet. Complete your registration at home, print out registration, then walk in, pay, and pick up candy.
- 3) Register at in-person registration and we will have board members available to help walk you through registering. This may involve a wait.

IMPORTANT DATES/NOTES:

- Opening Day/Picture Day Saturday, May 4th- All teams will play a scheduled scrimmage following pictures
- League games will begin the week of May 6th and conclude by July 18th
- Bat Rules- Bats must have the "USA Baseball" stamp to be legal for K-8 and "BBCOR" for high school league
- <u>Uniforms</u>- All players will receive a jersey shirt and hat to wear at games. Players must provide their own <u>gray</u> pants.

 Pants may have a thin braid down side of any color but no pinstripes. Players must wear league issued hats and jersey and gray pants to be eligible to play.
- Rainout make-up dates will be assigned by Fondy Youth Baseball and can be made up on Fridays if needed.
- Dockspiders Game/End of Season Celebration- Date to be determined in July- lots of fun events planned with prizes. This has been growing each year with more teams and players attending.
- Fall Baseball- We will again be having fall baseball leagues that run from Mid-August to end of September- Look for registration in June!
