

AYS Deposits Explained

AYS FUNDRAISING Deposits - AYS requires one \$200.00 check per child (please write child's name in the memo line), per year for fundraising volunteer deposits. (Fundraising volunteer calendar year starts on August 1st and runs through July 31 of the following year.) AYS FUNDRAISING deposit checks will be shredded if annual AYS fundraising volunteer commitment is fulfilled at an approved AYS fundraising event (tractor pull, poker run, bingo night, etc.). Fulfillment requirements are 1 'Credit' PER ATHLETE, per year enrolled in any AYS sport.

PLEASE DO NOT COMBINE CHECKS, INDIVIDUAL CHECKS MUST BE WRITTEN FOR EACH CHILD'S DEPOSITS AND REGISTRATION FEES IF REGISTRATION FEES ARE NOT PAID ONLINE. PLEASE WRITE THE CHILDS NAME IN THE MEMO LINE FOR EACH CHECK REQUIRED

AYS FUNDRAISING Deposit tracking - An AYS BOD (Board of Directors) member will be tracking the AYS Fundraising commitments. You are required to provide the AYS Fundraising deposit check (\$200) at the first sport your child participates in to that sports volunteer coordinator before participating in any activities for that sport. The sport volunteer coordinator will send the check to the BOD to be accounted for and held onto. AYS fundraising volunteer credits for fundraising events will be tracked through Dibs. When you are volunteering, please make sure you not only claim your dibs for that child, but also sign in at the event when you get there. Once your commitment is fulfilled, that check will be shredded (or returned if requested when submitted). One \$200.00 check PER CHILD annually is required.

AYS Individual Sport Volunteer Deposits - Individual sport volunteer deposit amounts will be set by each sport if that sport chooses to require a volunteer deposit. Volunteer commitments can include regular season play and playoff games, tournaments, or any other event each specific sport deems necessary. Number of credits required is determined by each sport and will be announced as soon as schedules are known. **PLEASE DO NOT COMBINE CHECKS, INDIVIDUAL CHECKS MUST BE WRITTEN FOR EACH CHILD'S DEPOSITS IF REQUIRED AND REGISTRATION FEES IF REGISTRATION FEES ARE NOT PAID ONLINE. PLEASE WRITE THE CHILDS NAME IN THE MEMO LINE FOR EACH CHECK REQUIRED**

AYS Individual Sport Volunteer Deposit tracking - Individual sport volunteer credits will be tracked by each sports volunteer coordinator through dibs. Deposit checks for individual sports will be held onto by the individual sport volunteer coordinator. Your volunteer deposit will NOT be cashed as long as all volunteer requirements for that specific sport are fulfilled. Once that sports season is complete and your individual sport volunteer requirements are fulfilled, your individual sport volunteer deposit check will be shredded (or returned if requested when submitted).

Coaching - If you coach a sport, you **DO NOT** need to fulfill the individual sport volunteer deposit for **THAT** child in the sport in which you are coaching, however you will still need to fulfill the AYS Fundraising credit for **THAT** child if it has not been fulfilled.

Exclusions - Soccer, T-Ball, and Coach Pitch exclusions are currently being discussed by the BOD and commisioners

What if.....

2 kids-one in basketball, one in baseball = 1 \$200 basketball deposit check, 1 \$200 baseball deposit check, 2 \$200 AYS Fundraising volunteer deposit checks.

Same scenario above but I coach basketball = No basketball check (no volunteer requirement for your family for basketball), 1 \$200 baseball check, 2 \$200 AYS Fundraising volunteer checks.

1 kid in 3 sports (basketball, baseball, wrestling) = \$200 basketball deposit, \$200 baseball deposit, \$200 wrestling deposit, 1 \$200 AYS Fundraising deposit

I'm on the sports board but do not coach, do I still need to volunteer? Yes, for the sport and for AYS Fundraising
