Directors Update-

Ice Arena Update-

- TIA- No games until further notice. Intra squad scrimmages ok (Scott R), House teams will need to be separated with mites dividers, cohorted teams can play games together there. (46)
- NYA- is the strictest rink in the state. Provided test results in outside state travel. They are concerned about state guidelines and they are getting guidance from higher up. (44)
- FIC- No spectators, masks, dressing inside (40 but up to 44)
- CBA- will be following FICs lead, no locker rooms, Option to have a state rep/cdc review as an outdoor rink for just COVID, would need to remove wind mesh, Come dressed and put helmets/skates on at the rink

-Looking at the potential of a half sheet outside next to CBA and run off the CBA chiller. Would need to pay and talk to Falmouth

-Expanding CBHA midgets to HS teams to get them on the ice if the HS season is delayed to Jan 1

Academy-(numbers as of 9/10/20)

- Capped LTP and BTI (waiting list email which is hard to navigate on the back end)
LTP- 36 registered (1 transfer from Midcoast)
BTI- 31 registered

- Last year they had 3 hours of ice and combined for the first half of the year due to numbers.

-Hold off on academy till Jan and then can evaluate then. Wait till final registration cut off of 9/20 to make this final decision.

Mites- (numbers as of 9/10/20)

- 117 players currently registered with 17 transfers. Program is capped at 121

- 61 players registered

PeeWee- (numbers as of 9/10/20)

- 35 players registered

Bantam- (numbers as of 9/10/20)

- 42 skaters and 5 goalies

T4 girls registration is 21 players between both U12/U14. Scott M is looking at outside girls and these teams historically fill up late.

101 coaches signed up this year and had 170 coaches last year.

Lost Ice-
