- Players will be evaluated for placement on travel team.
- Must be committed to tournament dates.
- Absence from tournament dates must be noted before evaluations.

Player Participation

- Once a roster is set, all players will be treated equal, and no distinction of Marshall or Non-Marshall player will be made. Playing time, will be decided by the team coach and will be based on player performance.** Playing time for travel teams will be fair but may not be equal.




