


WHS Girls Soccer Vision & Mission

A Woodbury girl's soccer player is dedicated to achieving excellence as a student athlete, dedicated to her team and teammates, and works to develop school and community pride.


A Woodbury Girls Soccer Player...

Tryouts & Team Formation: What to Expect 8/14 – 8/22

- Tryouts start on first day and teams are formed by last day
 - Player Meeting at 8:30 am on first day then Fitness Testing
- Practices during the week are how coaches assess players for teams
- For players that don't drive, we recommend carpooling with a teammate!
- Practice, locations, and times can change based on weather, coach discretion, etc.
 - Changes are communicated to the PLAYERS first from Coaches or Captains via GroupMe chat
 - Boosters attempt to keep up with schedule changes on the website, but your player should know first
- Selection: Tryouts are for the <u>Varsity Team</u>

After Varsity team is selected, remaining players are placed by grade level first and then spread throughout the teams as the numbers and skills are assessed.

 For example 11th & 12th Graders can play Varsity or JV; 10th Graders can only play B-Squad, JV, or Varsity

What is a Booster Club?








Duluth Trip – Aug 25 & 26

- Parents are welcome to attend games, but travel, accommodations, meals, etc. are on your own








2023 Fundraising Events – Planning Underway

What is it?

This role is the liaison between coach, parents, players and Boosters to help support their team.

The Team Rep will help with the following duties once teams are formed:

- Enter roster and player/parent contact list in TeamSnap (Boosters will give you TeamSnap account)
- Help with Player & Parent communication within the team using TeamSnap.
- Coordinate with other parents on your team to plan fun team events. (e.g Pasta feeds/team dinners, post-game treats, team activities etc.) Cost involved with these events will be contributed by the team/families.
- Send photos and game updates to Social Media Chair to post updates to Instagram and Twitter. Post-game scores, game highlight information, game photos, team activity photos
- Work along with team photographer(s) to ensure team photos are taken and uploaded into photo storage site. This will be used
 for the End-of-Season banquet.
- Coordinate with JV, B, 9th coaches on season-end uniform-turn-in and pizza party. Boosters cover the cost of Pizza Party.


