Position

Head or assistant coach, 12U or 14U girls fall travel volleyball

Duties/Physical Demands

- a. Conduct two 90-minute practices each week and league matches on weekends
- b. Ensure proper coverage between team coaches for every practice and match
- c. Develop & execute practice plans designed for improvement in both individual & team skills
- d. Act as a positive role model towards players, parents, opponents and officials
- e. Communicate attendance, participation & attitude expectations for players on a regular basis
- f. Communicate team information to parents on a regular basis
- g. Monitor player safety and welfare during practices and matches
- h. Maintain responsibility for the care and return of all equipment
