To complete the Hat Trick Growth Challenge, participating associations will utilize programs that emphasize the three main driving forces of growth Retention, Acquisition, and Conversion.
- Girls' Hockey weekend, host sites utilize various activities; season kick-off parties, cross-ice jamborees, try hockey for free, or create an original event to celebrate local female hockey players. Events are encouraged to focus on 8U age group, 2021 date is October 15-17, 2021

 - 1. Rule Changes, summary is attached to the minute for reference and can also be found at this link on USA Hockey. https://www.usahockey.com/rulesandresources Ensure you educated yourself on the changes as well as the current rules that are in place.
 - 2. Referees' numbers are very low, yet as a state we have new sheets of ice, and more referees will be needed as we move through the season. Please help recruit new referees in your areas to ensure the coming season is a successful one.
 - a. Spokane hockey association encourages their players to participate as referees and provides incentives such as paying their referee registration fees.
 - 3. For the upcoming PNAHA State tournaments, the Tier I and Tier II will need 2 referees and 2 linesmen. There will be a need for additional hotels from the hosts for referees due to the state shortage.
- Registrar/Risk Manager Jeremy McCann
 - 1. Player Releases must send these in to Jeremy and copy Rob Azevedo, PNAHA President (president@pnaha.com). Associations need to ensure you are getting releases from players who register with your programs that did not play in your association the previous year.
 - 2. Registration numbers are up over the previous year, we are close to be being back to numbers from 2 years ago.
 - 3. Portal Labels for scoresheets, Jeremy will address this at the upcoming registrar meeting but going forward this season, PNAHA is requesting all Nationally Bound Teams, and any other team to work with their association registrar to get a sticker template with your registered players/coaches out of the portal. This will help with credential checks and assist teams with knowing who can and can not be on their rosters.
 - 4. Flex Rosters from the portal. All associations should be using their portal to claim their volunteers and billets and adding them to a flex roster for easy verification that everyone has been screened and done their Safesport. This is a key piece that everyone needs to ensure is being done.

Pg. 76 ADD - SECTION 9

Girls/Women's Director (NON-VOTING MEMBER)

It shall be the responsibility of the Girls/Women's Director for the planning, development and conduct of the girls/women's hockey within PNAHA. Shall work directly with each Affiliate in growing interest towards independent girls/women's programs. Will have the responsibility of planning, scheduling, and maintaining the budget for the Girls/Women's Development Camp. As the Girls/Women's Director you will be responsible for administering the PNAHA evaluation process and the selection of PNAHA players to any USA Hockey camps or events.

- This was a new position from USA Hockey adopted by PNAHA but the description was not added to the guidebook. This is to add general duties to the guidebook for the position. Debbie Didzerekis (PNAHA Secretary/Treasurer) motion [to accept the addition to the guide book for the Girls/Women's Director (Non-Voting member)] 2nd by Penny Delbarto (WSHC). All in favor, motion passed.
- Update to Guidebook page 87:
 - a. Each Tier II National bound team Youth (14U, 15O, 16U, 18U, and Girls 14U, 16U, 19U) that has been identified by their association representative at the PNAHA Annual Fall meeting must play each National Bound team in their age classification a minimum of 4 games during the season (2 home and 2 away). 50% of the required games must be completed by November 15 and the remainder must be completed 14 days prior to the Affiliate Tournament.
 - b. All Tier II National Bound Teams must be declared by October 1st.
 - c. All Tier II National Bound teams must be certified according to the criteria set for
