

CEVA CLUB DIRECTORS' UPDATES – 2/9/2023

- 12s teams are required, by CEVA policy, to have a rostered adult, or an older (16+) player, be present at the score table to assist the junior work team. This policy will be strictly enforced at the next Power League in March. Teams who do not meet this requirement will be subject to a monetary fine. Having the individual at the table helps keep the workers on track and makes things more efficient.
- R2s need to have whistles. If they don't have a whistle, you can always visit your tournament director, who will have whistles you can buy for \$5 and keep for the season.
- We strongly recommend checking out with your tournament director prior to departing a tournament site. Make sure you don't have an additional match or a work assignment. Also, make sure you're checking the AES schedule throughout the day to track where upcoming matches or work assignments might be.
- We're still seeing several instances of teams showing up to events with non-compliant rosters. A legal roster (example <u>HERE</u>) has the USAV logo in the top right, a column for a membership number, and a column for eligibility. AES rosters are not required for any CEVA-owned events (such as Power League, Presidents' Day, or Regionals).
- Teams who registered for the Bid Tournament can find more information about that event **ON THE BID TOURNAMENT WEBSITE**. If your team is moved to "OK TO PAY" in AES, it means they have qualified for the tournament.
