


I have completed my 6<sup>th</sup> wrestling season as Head Wrestling Coach, (along with Coach McGinnis) and would have to rank this season as one of the most enjoyable. Myself, along with all of the other wrestling coaches in the Edwardsville Wrestling program (McGinnis, Mestemacher, Matarelli, Freitag, Followell, Lewis, etc.) wanted to develop a tradition of strong wrestling here at Edwardsville. Our Varsity continued that "Tradition" by having another action packed, successful season. Many of you see the competitiveness come out of me, as I am quite emotional in big wins, along with frustrating losses. This is due to the extreme amount of hard work these young men put into a wrestling season and career, and I would like them to receive all the rewards for their work and determination. This year the Varsity had another outstanding dual record of 17-3. We had an exciting come from behind win at the Murdale Tournament, placed 3<sup>rd</sup> at a very difficult Granite City Tournament (school best), and were runner – ups at a very competitive Mascoutah Invite. We placed 2<sup>nd</sup> in a very tough Southwestern Conference, but yet were once again kept out of the Dual Team State series, because of a runner-up finish at Regionals to state representative Granite City. Although we were left watching at the Team Sectional, no team was as close to Granite as the Tigers.

Once again, as has been the case in the last few years, we are losing a bulk of our line-up. A very competitive J.V. and Freshman squads will be looking to fill these spots. Many coaches in the area are writing the Tigers off as being a perennial contender. I take this as a challenge, as I hope our younger wrestlers do.
