Myself, along with all of the other wrestling coaches in the Edwardsville Wrestling program (McGinnis, Mestemacher, Matarelli, Freitag, Followell, Lewis, etc.) wanted to develop a tradition of strong wrestling here at Edwardsville. Many of you see the competitiveness come out of me, as I am quite emotional in big wins, along with frustrating losses. 
