


HOBEY BAKER MEMORIAL AWARD FOUNDATION | Character Builds Excellence

THE HOBEY BAKER MEMORIAL AWARD COLLEGE HOCKEY'S MOST PRESTIGIOUS AWARD

- The most coveted award in collegiate hockey; established in 1981.
- Annually recognizes college hockey's most outstanding player; named for the early twentieth century athlete widely regarded to be the first great American hockey player.
- Candidates must:
 - o Exhibit strength and character both on and off the ice
 - o Contribute to the integrity of the team
 - o Display outstanding skills in all phases of the game
 - Show scholastic achievement and sportsmanship
- Winner is selected from ten finalists by a selection committee of 30 individuals representing print and electronic sports media, college hockey coaches and officials, and NHL scouts.
- Top Ten finalists are selected by the coaches of the 60 Division I colleges and universities that play Division I hockey.

 - o Coachability and commitment
 - Outstanding sportsmanship
 - Community spirit
 - o Academic achievement





HOBEY BAKER: BEHIND THE LEGEND

- Two-sport star at Princeton where the hockey arena is named for him; captained football and hockey.
- First American inducted into the Hockey Hall of Fame, which named him the first American hockey star; also in the U.S. Hockey Hall of Fame and College Football Hall of Fame.
- Decorated American war hero; officer and aviator, member of the Lafayette Escadrille; awarded the Croix de Guerre for "exceptional valor under fire."
- Symbol of the highest ideals of character and sportsmanship, his name was cut in the walls of the Sports Bay and Chapel in the Cathedral of St. John the Divine in NY.
- Pioneered the tradition of a post-game handshake as the highest symbol of sportsmanship; win or lose, Hobey made it a point to shake the hand of every opponent after every game.
