BOTTOM LINE CAPTURES 1991 TITLE BY THRASHING BLACK MAGIC 9-0, 9-1!!

ABE COHEN LIMITED BLACK MAGIC TO JUST ONE RUN ON 9 HITS OVER 14 INNINGS!!

Abe Cohen, Abe Cohen, Abe Cohen!! That's the complete story of this 1991 World Series. Abe allowed a total of six runs through the 4 games played in the World Series. If you count only the games Abe won, then Abe allowed only 1 run over 21 innings pitched!! BLACK MAGIC managed only 25 hits in 101 at bats for a paltry .248 batting average. And yes, Abe can hit too! Abe hit 7 for 12 with 4 R.B.I.s during the 4 game series. BOTTOM LINE and BLACK MAGIC entered the day with the series tied at one game apiece. In the first game, BOTTOM LINE sent 9 men to the plate in the 1st inning and scored 3 runs. In the following inning BOTTOM LINE sent another 9 men to the plate for 5 more runs and commanding 8-0 lead!! Abe Cohen delivered a 2 out R.B.I. single in the 1st inning and a 2 out 2 run double in the 2nd inning. Erwin Braha and Joey Cohen also came through in the clutch with 2 out R.B.I. doubles of their own! Bobby Kassin and Victor Zilberman contributed with 2 hits apiece and 2 runs scored. Abe shut down BLACK MAGIC on 4 hits (all singles) to take this first game 9-0.

Once again it was do or die for BLACK MAGIC. All season long they thrived in this type of situations, but NOT TODAY! BLACKMAGIC took a 1-0 lead in the 2nd inning on a couple of singles by Fred Weintraub, and Jesse Sutton with a Joey Tawil sac fly. But that was the last run BLACK MAGIC would score this season. In the 6th inning Bobby (Wheels) Kassin snapped a 1-1 deadlock with an R.B.I. triple. Jack Haddad drove in Bobby for a 3-1 lead. Then with 2 outs, Erwin (Kingman) Braha and Abe Cohen ripped consecutive doubles for a 4-1 lead. In the 7th inning, Bobby Kassin struck again with a 2 run single for a commanding 6-1 lead. Jacky Haddad, Erwin Braha, and Joey Cohen brought home the final 3 runs to finish this World Series massacre!

What It Takes To Complete The Newspaper!

Two weeks ago I was sitting at home working on the newspaper and a friend called to see if I wanted to go see a movie with him. I started to tell him that I was in the middle doing the paper when I realized that no one but Freddie Harrari and myself really know what it takes to get this out on time. So since it is the last paper of the year I decided to write a little article about how the paper gets done from Start to Finish.

Score Keepers:

Everyone knows about these guys who record the game in such exacting detail that we can tell you who was on what base in every game of the whole season. These guys finish up the totals for the each player of each game and pass them to Freddie.

Freddie Harrari:

Very few realize exactly how much time Freddie puts in on this paper. He literally is the soul of the paper. He comes up with the articles basically organizes the layout, and maintains the mailing list (actually he has 2 one for before people come out for the summer and on for after). He is much to modest to put his name in here, but deserved it more than anyone. He also checks the box scores on a weekly basis. Freddie take the score books, the articles and any pictures to Scott's house on Sunday Night (some times as late as 11:00 PM!!).

Michelle Bart:

Michelle is the person who takes the hand written articles and types them into a basic computer file. She is chief reason that the spelling on the articles are as good as they are. (Which is why the one week she could not type the paper the spelling was terrible!).

Scott Goldenberg:

If Freddie is the soul of the paper Scott is the body. Its Scott's job to get the pictures scanned into the computer, select the typefaces for the articles, 'place' the simple text into the layout programs, produce all of the box scores, update the leaders, and produce the camera ready paper. On the average all of this is done by Tuesday 8:00 PM, though on rare occasions it is done by Monday night.

Red Nesser:

Red handles all of the logistics of getting the paper to the printer on time. The printer has to have the paper 1st thing in the morning or it takes an additional day to print. (That means that if the its not there by 9:30 AM it is not mailed until Thursday afternoon!)

The Print Shack:

These guys are the only print shop that will print the paper in one day. They have stop orders ten times as large just to meet our deadline.

The Post Office:

Once all of this is done, the post office should get the paper to you by Friday or Saturday, so you can read it before the game on Sunday.

Once the paper is in the mail, its not quite done. Freddie then verifies the box scores and updates the Master records so that even if there is a mistake in the box score it is recorded correctly for the next weeks leaders.

OZAR HATORAH

THE OZAR HATORAH ORGANIZATION HAS BEEN MENTIONED MANY TIMES IN THIS NEWSLETTER. WE WOULD LIKE TO TAKE THIS OPPORTUNITY TO EXPLAIN TO YOU WHAT THE "OZAR HATORAH" ORGANIZATION STANDS FOR, AND ITS PAST ACCOMPLISHMENTS AS WELL AS THEIR FUTURE GOALS.

OZAR HATORAH: THEN AND NOW

Ozar Hatorah, the renown international educational organization, builds and revitalizes Jewish communities in neglected areas of the globe by providing religious and secular education to children and adults who would not otherwise have the opportunity to learn about our heritage and take pride in our identity.

Ozar Hatorah's campuses serve as centers of spiritual guidance, inspiring and drawing closer to the Torah way of life. Ozar Hatorah students transmit our values and traditions to their own families, enabling them, in turn, to take their rightful places in the ranks of our people.

Ozar Hatorah was the vision of Mr. Isaac Shalom, a businessman from Syria who sought to aid the culturally devastated Sephardic communities of the post-war world. With the help of dedicated activist, Joseph Shamah, and renown Torah educator, Rabbi Solomon D. Sassoon, Shalom founded Ozar Hatorah in 1946 to serve the one million or so Jews then living in an arc stretching from Morocco on the Atlantic to Iran in the Persian Gulf.

To help ease their abrupt transition into a rapidly changing world in which assimilation was becoming a spiralling threat, Ozar Hatorah recruited educators and administrative personnel and began to establish quality Jewish schools and scholastic programs in even the remotest towns and villages. Over the years, more than 127 Ozar Hatorah schools and programs have been operational in Israel, Syria, Lebanon, and Libya, as well as in Iran, Morocco, and France, where it is still active today.

Currently in France, Ozar Hatorah maintains a thriving network of 18 schools, 7 of which have been built within the last five years.

In Morocco, although the Jewish population is dwindling due to emigration, and has decreased from 500,000 to roughly 7,000, Ozar Hatorah is still educating over 700 students.

In the Near East, it is meeting all the religious needs of the ancient Persian community which yet remains - the only religious educational organization still operative in that region.

Ozar Hatorah is also a participant in Argentina, where it recently to establish a dormitory in Buenos Aires. In conjunction with the American Jewish Joint Distribution Committee, it recently dispatched a representative to explore the educational needs of Jews in the Soviet Union, targeting the Asiatic towns of Baku, Samarkan, and Tashkent among others.

Currently, Ozar Hatorah is working closely with Mr. Albert Reichmann on a campaign to benefit the sole Jewish school in Hungary - the first of its kind since the Holocaust. Plans are also afoot to expand into Canada, and the West Coast, U.S.A., where the Syrian community came forward with a request for outreach.

Ozar Hatorah's work is actively championed by leading international Rabbinic and business personalities, notably the Chief Rabbis of Israel and France, the Reichmann Family, Edmond Safra, and a dedicated group of community leaders in New York, spearheaded by Joseph Chehebar, Alex Adjmi and Sam A. Sutton.

A fresh and vital source of inspiration is Ozar Hatorah's new young leadership committee, a dynamic group of rising executives which came together to further awareness in the young sector of the community toward the needs of our nation worldwide, and the important role it can presently play to shape the future course of Jewish history.

Through the concern, support and united efforts of dedicated individuals, Ozar Hatorah will, B'ezrat Hashem, uphold its vital mission of revitalizing Jewish communities throughout the Diaspora. Wherever the need exists, Ozar Hatorah will strive to fulfill it by safely passing the key to our nation's future into the hands of the next generation.
