### 1. Coaches Update

## • Purchases, Wants, Needs

- We received the new Varsity green jerseys. Of the two quotes, BSN was less expensive, so the total cost was \$1716.90.
- Budget approved for Tuesday/Thursday coaches to be present at Irish Gym. 22 girls are currently signed up.
- Mike Manning lowered what we owe for transportation to \$750.

### • Summer On/Off Court Training

- Currently 18 girls are signed up for Irish Gym, so we owe \$100. If we get 20 girls to sign up, then we break even.
- There are 20 sessions in June and July. If we get more girls to register and therefore break even, then we'll consider additional sessions in August.

## • Summer Team Camp

- Captains decided on the U of M camp starting 6/22, which is \$400/team.

### • Summer League

- Summer League at Concordia starts 6/12. Currently 20-21 girls are signed up.

## • HUDL Update

- While deciding between Crossover (\$900) and HUDL (\$1440), we learned that HUDL bought Crossover. Therefore, Coach will go to 5/31 meeting to discuss situation.

#### Hope Fieldhouse Update

- They're at 1.5 million and need 2 million to break ground, and their target to be up and running is January 2020.

### • Rosemount Rec Center Update

- Coach will attend 5/21 meeting which is when idea is proposed to public.
- Rec center is different than Hope Fieldhouse because Rec Center will be city-owned, located near DCTC, and have two courts (eventually expand to have six courts, a sheet of ice, and outdoor pool).

### • Sections Update

- The only change is that the 2<sup>nd</sup> round will be located at the high seed's location.

## 2. Fundraising/Financials Update

The current bank balance is \$18,131.65, which includes the uniforms that have arrived.

For a donation of \$1-2 (?) kids would have a chance to win a jersey.
