Marching Band Volunteer Opportunities – *Marching Band involves 10th-12th grade band students but 9th grade parents are always welcome*

#1 #2 **Marching Band Uniform Fittings** – August 15th or 16th (sign-up online NOW if you can help)

This involves uniform fitting of pants / coats and sizing shoes, hats and gloves. Commitment: August 15th or 16th morning and/or afternoon timeframes as you are available. Pick date(s) and a.m. or p.m. slots (A.M.=7:30-11:00 / P.M.=11:30- 3:30)

#1 #2 **Game Crew for Football Games**

This involves transporting plastic tarps, coolers, color guard equipment, student coats, etc. to the stadium, setting up area for band in the end zone and assisting with halftime performance needs. Commitment: 5:00 – 9:30 p.m. on game nights

#1 #2 **Uniform Distribution and Collection for before and after games and concerts.**

Commitment- Eve games: 5 -6 pm/9 – 10 pm / Homecoming day: 11:30 am – 12:45 pm /9 – 10 pm / Band Extravaganza Concert: 6 – 6:45 pm/9 – 10 pm

#1 #2 **Field Escort** – escort band in and out of the stadium at football games with light-sabers - *Commitment: Before and after game – watch the game in between.*

#1 #2 **Homecoming Parade Chaperone** – *Commitment: Fri., October 11, from 2:45 – 4:15 pm*

#1 #2 **Homecoming Subway Dinner** – *Commitment: Fri., October 11 after parade. One person is needed at 4 pm to meet the delivery driver, check order, and arrange on table – all others meet at 4:15 pm to prepare dinner for band (9th grade parent needed for the 4 pm delivery if possible)*

#1 #2 **Uniform hemming and mending** – August 15-16 / December TBD (please sign-up online NOW if you can help)

This involves hemming pants and adjusting sleeve lengths on 3-5 uniforms following student fittings in August for Marching Band and December for Concert Band.

#1 #2 **PB&J - Pancake Breakfast & Jammin' Committee Co-Chair** – Leaders and assistant chairs are needed for various committees to help produce this event

#1 #2 **PB&J - Pancake Breakfast & Jammin' Event Worker** – MANY people are needed to produce this huge band fundraiser – (folks NOT wanting to chair)

Additional Volunteer Opportunities

#1 #2 **Concert Usher** – *sell tickets at the door, hand out programs, monitor student behavior in as needed*

#1 #2 **Lead Contact for A Band Concert Reception** – *May involve ordering cakes, making punch making sure there are enough supplies, in addition to organizing the reception. You will be given a "how-to" document*

#1 #2 **Post-Concert Reception Helper** – *help decorate tables and serve punch and cookies / cake*

#1 #2 **Chaperone** afterschool, weekend, or overnight trips – *Might include Homecoming Parade, Solo and Ensemble Contest, Big Nine Music Festival, or annual JM Band Tour for 10th – 12th grade band students.*

#1 #2 **JM Band Booster Board position for 2019-2020** – *Monthly board meetings where you help plan and facilitate production of the JM Band program throughout the year. This is a 2-year commitment.*
