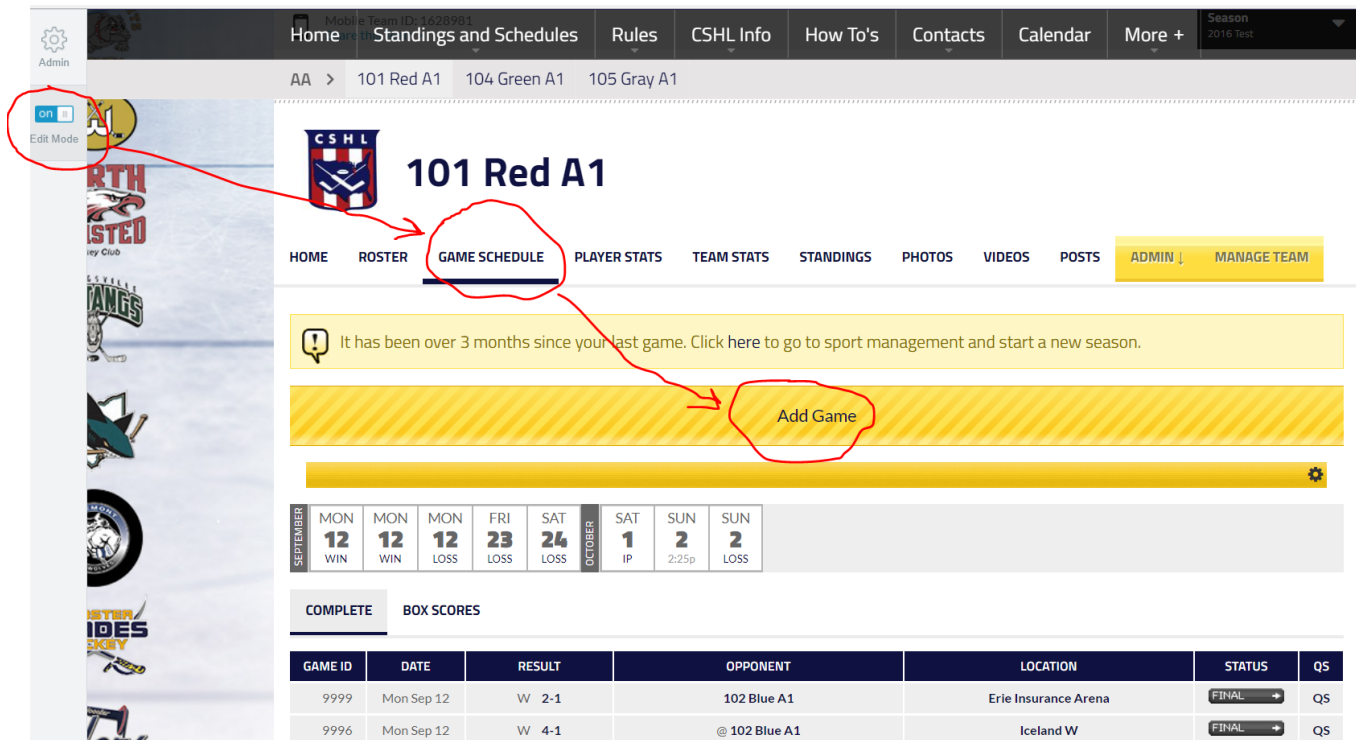


Creating Non-League Games Should not be done from the SportsEngine App. Games Added via the App will be defaulted to impact league standings. If you want to add Non-League Games or Non-League Tournament Games they need to be added while logged in to the CSHL Website and in Edit Mode you can "Add Game". Note that you can not turn Edit Mode until you are on your own Team Page.

From your Team Page>"Game Schedule", Turn on "Edit Mode. Select "Add Game"



Select the Team 2 as "TBD", Scroll Down Or Pick another Team from the league from the drop down

Add a Unique Game ID prefer creator initials and date

Scroll Down to "STANDINGS OVERRIDES" Select drop down.

Select drop down "Standings Options" and change to "Does not Effect Standings"

This is a required Step as the game will impact league standings.
