We need parents to help us reach these goals so that we continue being the best game in town.





## Why Play Bear Babe Ruth?

- **Lowest prices** We have the lowest registration fees in the area not to mention our 50% discount on one child's registration for managing a team.
- We teach the game and develop player's baseball knowledge We continue practices even after games begin.
- **Minimal rainouts** Our fields have some of the best drainage around. Postponements are made up ASAP.
- We play against other leagues during the season Minors divisions and older, may see some opponents outside of BBR. Based on availability, we can see how we stack up against other local competition.
- **Majors Division** ages 10-12 get to play on a 50/70 field making the transition to the 'big field" at age 13 easier.
- **All-Star program** 9U and up shorter road to the US championship than other leagues and the championship is held somewhere different every year. 2023's 12U championship was held in Branson, MO!

# **Typical Practice/Game Schedules**

#### T-Ball:

**Practices** – 1 or 2 weekday practice/week prior to start of games **Practices Begin** – Week of *March 18th* **Games** – 2 / 3 games per week **Games Begin** – week of April 8<sup>th</sup>

#### **Rookie:**

Practices – 2 times per week
Practices Begin - Week of March 18
Games - 2 / 3 games per week
Games Begin – Week of April 8<sup>th</sup>

#### **Minors:**

**Practices** – 2 weekday practices per week prior to start of games **Practices Begin** – at manager's discretion anytime after February 26<sup>th</sup> **Games** – 2 / 3 games per week **Games Begin** - week of April 8<sup>th</sup>

\*Inter-league games dependent on other leagues ability to field teams



# Typical Practice/Game Schedules (cont.)

#### **Majors:**

**Practices** – 2 practices per week prior to start of games **Practices Begin** - at manager's discretion anytime after February 26<sup>th</sup> **Games** – 2 / 3 weekday games per week **Games Begin** - week of April 8<sup>th</sup>

#### **Seniors:**

Practices – at manager's discretion beginning early May
Practices Begin – early May
Games – typically Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays through end of June
Games Begin – mid-May

#### **Super Seniors:**

Practices – frequency/days at manager's discretion

**Practices Begin** – end of May

**Games** – 3x per week (including weekends – 12 to 15 game season)

Games Begin – early to mid June - season ends in July – games are all

#### **Code of Conduct**

# THESE ARE KIDS. THIS IS A GAME. COACHES ARE VOLUNTEERS. UMPIRES ARE HUMAN. MAJOR LEAGUE CONTRACTS ARE NOT HANDED OUT AFTER GAMES.

The Code requires respectful treatment of all; specifically BBR strives to create an environment where there is:

- An emphasis on the positive for all players
- Patience and support
- •A learning environment where mistakes made are turned into opportunities to teach
- Respectful treatment of all BBR equipment
- •We ask that parents, family members and friends remain outside dugouts and fenced playing fields **AT ALL TIMES** during the games and practices
- Support for the manager and coaches:
  - Notify them when your child will miss practice or a game
  - Speak privately with them regarding concerns
  - •Remember 30 minutes **PRIOR** and **AFTER** a game is time reserved for pre and post game preparations and is **NOT** a good time for discussion

#### Code of Conduct continued...

#### New bylaw as of 2023:

- T-Ball/Rookie Divisions players must have an adult remain in attendance during all practices/games for their entirety
- Minors/Majors/Seniors Divisions If a parent/guardian must leave practice or a game, they must notify a coach prior to leaving. This request will be permitted at coach's discretion.

<u>Consequence:</u> 2 behavior incidents will result in an adult needing to be present for the season's remaining practices/games - if 3 incidents then the player will be removed from the league without refund.

#### What happens if the Code is not followed ??

Non-compliance of any of the Code of Conduct principals could result in:

- Ejection from a game
- Forfeiting the right to continue to participate in the league, and/or
- Disqualification from any post season tournaments for players

#### **Problem Escalation Procedure:**

- 1. First, try the Manager
- 2. Next, contact will be the Division Coordinator
- 3. Last, go to the Board of Directors
