Meeting called to order: Dan called the meeting to order at 6:07 pm.

New Business:

- *Senior Scholarship Applications* - There is no official application process through OYH to apply for this program. We just want to show that we support the seniors in their next stage in life. Andy Meyer will put together a rough draft to submit to the board for approval.
- **(Dan)** *End of Season Ice - structure for State teams now that we know who is all going and when* - Lots of teams going to State for the organization. WAHA has now spread out the State tournaments over weekends. What can we do to get each team a full sheet of ice prior to them going to State. Dan will look at the master schedule to try and make it work for each team.
- *General Membership meeting date - What do we think about having it at Christys Landing before the Meat Raffle in hopes to get more attendance and participation from the membership?* - Is April too late to hold the General Membership meeting? This could pose an issue with setup and other volunteers trying to get ready for the meat raffle. The space might not accommodate what we are looking to accomplish. We will plan to just promote the upcoming membership meeting at the meat raffle to raise awareness. As of now, the general membership meeting will still be held in April.

Old Business :

- *Jerseys for next year* -
 - Ben and Tessa from Little Big Promotions. Production time is 4-5 weeks and we would get it in hand in 6-7 weeks. Jerseys could be ordered at any time throughout the season and we would not have to wait for a bulk order to process. They can do lots of other things besides just uniforms. Average jerseys would run \$60-\$70 each and \$30 for socks. They can match our current jerseys so families would not have to purchase jerseys for their existing player if they wanted. We should also look into separate socks for the white jerseys.
 - Grant Gorman that runs the rink pro shop. Can match the jerseys close enough that people would not need to buy new ones that didn't need to. Endeavour hockey would be the supplier. They are based out of China. A link could be provided during registration and taken to the manufactures site for ordering. \$59 per jersey and \$22 for socks. Sizing could be done in the pro shop. Turnaround time is 2-3 weeks plus 3 days shipping.
- **(Dan)** *Jolene Ferguson will stay on as Webmaster but does not want to do the calendar* - Yes, she does plan to stay on as long as its only website design stuff.
- Playdowns at the rink went well. We had help from various members which we are grateful for. We should bring our own folding table next year so we have our own space to work.

Girls Update (Sharon) -

- Trying to figure out what next season will look like.
 - 8U will still remain co-ed for the regular season with the option to go to all girl jamborees.
 - 10U sent out a survey and there was almost 100% satisfaction. The current plan is to still have 2 teams hosted by Oregon. They are wanting to add a 3rd ice touch in McFarland for the teams.
 - 12U do we want to have 1 team close to home or have 2 teams with more travel for all the players. Right now they are leaning towards 2 teams.

- Currently at \$47k in the bank with both big fundraisers on the horizon. We have still not received any dues from any of the girls teams. All ice dues have been paid to the rink for the season. We still owe for goalie training as well.
- With the potential cost of increased ice fees for next season, Dan is going to sit down and work with Ben about a new contract and what rates the youth currently pays. Do we need to look into ice at other locations to help fill the need for ice time?
