

What is a weekly gas run???

A volunteer will pick the Jerry can(s) from the gas locker at Sandy Run, fill it up at a nearby gas station and return it to the gas locker. And finally, email a picture of the receipt to the treasurer (treasurer@warhawkcrew.org) for reimbursement. Below are specific instructions and details to help you.

1. Where do I find the Jerry cans?

If you stand at the top of the hill (right after the last parking lot) facing the river, you will find a metal cage to your right. This is the gas cage where all crew programs have their gas lockers/cabinets. JMHS uses cabinet # 6. As you walk into the gas cage, the second to last cabinet on the right is our locker. The middle and bottom shelves of this cabinet belong to JMHS. Top shelf belongs to another program.



2. Do I need a key?

No, the cage and the lockers are not locked. Just remember to close the cabinet and cage door every time.

3. How many Jerry cans do I fill?

It varies week-to-week depending on consumption. If a can is less than half full, please fill it up. If in doubt, fill it up.

NOTE: Please make sure that when you are done, the total fuel adds up to at least 3 full cans (~15 gallons).

4. Do I add any additive or fuel stabilizer?

Yes, remember to add a ½ oz of fuel additive to each empty 5 gallon Jerry can before you take them out to fill up. If the can is half empty, then add ¼ oz. You will find the required fuel additive (STA-BIL) in our gas locker.



5. Where do I fill up?

At a nearby gas station. You can google it up.

Apr 2021 - The nearest gas station is under renovation. So the next closest is at 8965 Village Shops Dr, Fairfax Station, VA 22039.

6. Can I do the gas run while the team is on water?

7. Where do I put the filled up Jerry cans

Bottom shelf of our gas locker.

8. How do I get reimbursed?

Email a copy of the receipt to treasurer@warhawkcrew.org. Our treasurer will send you a check.

NOTE: The gas cans could be a bit dirty/oily. You may want to take a few paper towels to clean your hands with; and a cardboard (or Costco-type cardboard boxes) to use while transporting cans in your car. We cannot stock these flammables in the locker.
