Treasurer's Report: Ken Snider

- Ken provided updates and financial statement for the month of October to the BOD prior to meeting via email dated 11/1/2022 which is summarized as follows:
 - $\circ~$ Raffle sales of \$469.00 deposited as of 10/31/2022.
 - Additional Sports Engine Scholarship Donations of \$190.00 were deposited into Greenwood Scholarship Account. As of 11/1/2022, balance in scholarship account is \$5484.92.
 - Ken is reimbursing Board members Kim DeWit for holiday decorations expenses incurred last year in the amount of \$110.36 and Steve Strickland in the amount of \$446.37 for expenses incurred this summer including:
 - Boats n Floats: Parks & Rec rental = \$75.00 and food= \$70.96
 - New raffle display board and associated expenses = \$255.41
 - Greenbelt Brewery Tour summer = \$14.00
 - Greenbelt Brewery Tour Fall = \$31.00
 - Cliff spent \$62.94 for food and refreshments for last Board meeting.
 - The operating account as of 10/31/2022 has a balance of approximately \$61,015.25 less trip transactions and minor miscellaneous for a total in operating funds of \$13,297.00.
 - A BBSC raffle booth was set up at Luxe theater in Eagle on 10/28 in relation to fundraiser that McU's and 10 Barrel are participating in for the Idaho Foodbank. Fifty percent of proceeds from BBSC raffle sales will be donated to Foodbank. This was voted on via emails with majority of Board in favor 10/28/2022. \$105.00 needs to go to Foodbank.
