# Entries:

Three entries for all individual events and one relay.

All races will be timed finals. Fastest section shall be run last when there are multiple sections.

## **Electronic Devices**

NFHS rules pertaining to electronic equipment will be strictly enforced. The use of electronic devices is not allowed in the competition area which is defined as anywhere inside the fence surrounding the track.

## Facility Access

Team access to the Track & Field Stadium will begin 90 minutes prior to the start of the first event (1:15). On track warm-ups may begin at 1:30.

# Infield Access

Access to the infield is reserved for competing athletes only! Coaches may not access the infield for safety reasons. Observation of field events must be from outside the event venue. All non-competing athletes <u>must</u> be outside the track fence.

# Implements

All throwing implements must be weighed and inspected at the equipment storage building on the east end of the track between 1:15 and 2:15.

## Spike Check

Only ¼" pyramid spikes are permitted (3/8" recessed pyramid spikes are permitted for the High Jump). All spikes will be checked at the clerking area.

## Starting Heights

Exact starting heights will be determined by meet management after all entries are received.

## <u>Tape</u>

Tape for any marking on the track must be white athletic tape. <u>NO</u> other tape will be allowed and <u>no</u> chalk is to used on runways or high jump surfaces. Tennis balls are recommended but not provided for relay marks and no unyielding objects (bottle caps) may be used.

## Team Camps

Team camps must be set up on the West/Northwest end of the track on the grassy areas.

## Warm-ups

Warm-ups may begin on the track and at field event venues starting at 1:30. There <u>must</u> be a coach or field event official present at all field events prior to warm-ups beginning. The track will be cleared 10 minutes prior to the first track event. The back stretch may be used during main straightaway events and when non-lane events are in session.

**<u>Admissions</u>: All cashless ticket sales.** Purchase in advance at <u>CHS GoFan</u> or by credit card at the gate.

Spectators should enter using the road by Cowles Stadium in the Athlete's Village area.

## Parking

General parking is available in the Fourth Street Ramp and Lot C37. Prices are subject to change and rates may vary based on specific lots and other events on campus.

Team buses may drop off and pick-up on the Athlete's Village service road between Bierman Athletic Building and Larson Football Performance Center. Team buses should enter at 516 15<sup>th</sup> Ave. SE, proceed to the back of the building, drop off by the gold Minnesota sign and exit on SE 8<sup>th</sup> St.

Buses will be asked to park along 6<sup>th</sup> Street between 23<sup>rd</sup> Ave. and 25<sup>th</sup> Ave. (Between the Ski-U-Mah and Victory Lots). Buses will NOT be allowed to stage in Athlete's Village, please call your bus driver when your team is ready to be picked up.

## **Trainers**

The trainers will be located on the east side of the grandstand.

## Weather Policy

In the event of inclement weather the stadium must be cleared, everyone may take shelter under the stadium. Please follow all PA instructions regarding weather.

<u>**4 x 800 Relay</u>** Start line/alley is green, cut after one turn at the green break line. All exchange zones are</u> (blue to blue).

# 100/110 High Hurdles

Start line is white. Hurdle marks are yellow (girls) 33", blue (boys) 39".

## <u>100 Dash</u>

Start line is white.

## <u>4 x 200 Relay</u>

Start line is black. First exchange (black to black), second exchange (black to black), last exchange (gold to gold). Lanes all the way.

## <u>1600</u>

Double waterfall alleys are white. Hold alleys for one turn, cut at the break line (green).

# 4 x 100 Relay

Start line is white. All zones (gold to gold).

# <u>400</u>

Start line is white. Lanes all the way.

## 300 L/IM Hurdles

Start line is white. Hurdle marks black, (girls) 30", (boys) 36".

## <u>800</u>

Start line/alley is green. Hold lane/alley for one turn, cut at the break line (green).

# <u>200 Dash</u>

Start line is white.

# <u>3200</u>

Double waterfall alleys are white. Hold alleys for one turn, cut at the break line (green).

## <u>4 x 400 Relay</u>

Start line is red. Leadoff runner lanes all the way. First exchange (blue to blue) in lanes. Second runner hold lane, cut at the break line (green). Second and third exchanges are (blue to blue).
