CMRC Board and Committee Structure

Executive Board

Purpose: To make all executive decisions and be responsible for overall direction. Additionally responsible for making sure all board members and committee leaders are held accountable. *President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer*

Finance Committee

Purpose: To oversee the finances of the board. This includes all banking, fundraising, and expenditures. Financial decisions cannot be made without being reviewed by the finance committee.

Treasurer, plus three additional spots

Fundraising Committee

Purpose: To raise funds for council goals. Plan council wide fundraising events and support individual sports in their fundraising efforts. A member of this committee should have frequent conversations with the Marketing and Communications committee.

Board Member Chair, plus three additional spots

Marketing and Communications Committee

Purpose: To provide council wide marketing and communications. Ideally there would be someone tasked with website, data management, and social media. The remaining two would then help with overall direction and support.

Board Member Chair, plus four additional spots.

Land/Field Management

Purpose: To oversee the maintenance and management of fields and equipment. Support coaches in determining additional needs.

Board Member Chair, plus two additional spots.

Capital Campaign (Land Trust)

What is a Capital Campaign? At its core, a capital campaign is a drawn out, extensive fundraiser. But at a more complex level, a capital campaign is a concerted effort to raise a substantial amount of money for a specific project or undertaking
