CBHA Financial Update:

Registrar review of final enrollment totals for 20-21 season:

- 793 players registered after we sent players back to original organizations.
- 70/30 boys to girls
- We have the exact same number of players registered this date as of 10/1/2019
- New protocols for coaches registrations for next year. All coaches need X, Y and Z done before registering. Early deadline for coaches next year
