Tom Drohner has been a Coach at Stevens Point Area Senior High for 20 years. He has coached in 533 games during that time picking 468 wins and continues to coach with a current record of 468-65 through the 2017 season. He has won 19 Conference Championships, 17 Regional Championships and 14 Sectional Championships. SPASH advanced to the State Tournament 14 times and has won the State Championship in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2008, 2009, 2011, and 2016 with a Runner-up in 2000 under his tenure. He is the only coach in Wisconsin State softball history to win 4 consecutive State Championships from 2001 thru 2004. He has help develop 48 first team All-State players, won 18 consecutive Wisconsin Valley Conference (WVC) Championships, coached 2 Gatorade players of the year, and 3 Wisconsin Fastpitch Softball Coaches Association (WFSCA) players of the year, and 12 WVC Players of the Year. He was named the National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) Coach of the Year for the State of Wisconsin four times 2004, 2008, 2009, and 2011.

Tom is married to his Wife Kate Drohner since 1994, and they have four Children, DJ, Aubrey, Avery, and Tommy. His daughter Aubrey, helped win the 2016 State Championship for SPASH and was named the Wisconsin Fastpitch Softball Coaches Association Co-Player of the year in the 2016 softball season.
