On Saturday, September 17th, 2022, your young athlete will be participating in the "Pink Game for Charity," a very special charitable event involving the UWSP Pointers and Youth Area Football. The game/event will be held at Community Stadium at Goerke Field in Stevens Point -- gates open at 5pm with kick off at 6pm.

The Pointers will be wearing one of a kind, custom jerseys at the event. **3rd & 4th** and **5th & 6th** YAF athletes will play a scrimmage at half-time while wearing a complementary Pink Game t-shirt and will receive FREE admission to the game. The free shirt will be handed out by the coach closer to game day. All YAF players will form a tunnel at the end of half-time for the UWSP players to run through.
