Purpose of Recreational/In-House Softball

10s Rec/In-House – players are introduced to/learn the game of softball and have fun.

10s and 12s Travel

For those girls interested in a more competitive level of play, a traveling team is offered. It requires a greater commitment, in that each player is expected to attend all practices and tournaments. Emphasis is on skill development, teamwork, and sportsmanship. For competitive play, a team size of 12 is ideal.

- Open roster spots not filled by a Marshall player can be filled by players not attending Marshall schools when approved by the MAFSA Board.
- Players will be evaluated for placement on travel team.
- Must be committed to tournament dates.
- Absence from tournament dates must be noted before evaluations.




