1. **Missing child** – Call the person in charge at the site (recreation Ryan or Jerry). If the child is found by a staff member and is able provide either their first and last name OR a parents first and last name the club can contact the parents. If this is not possible, we would call 911.

2. Severe weather –

All this is detailed on our website under policies and procedures.

For lightening, which is our biggest concern, if there is a lightening strike within 8 miles, we will postpone games 30 minutes. As long and there is not another strike within 8 miles, we would resume play after 30 minutes. If there is another strike games would be postponed another 30 minutes. All cancelation will be posted on our website at www.gjsoccer.org We will also send emails to all members (make sure your account is set up to receive emails from Fire FC. Only you can select that you do not want to receive emails from the club and this makes it so you will not receive any notifications). We will also post updates on social media.
