Ages 6-8, 9-11, 12 and up

Summer Junior Comps



First Tee's Summer Junior Camps are for children of all golf skills between the ages of 6 and 14. We cover a wide range of golf skills including putting, chipping, pitching, grip, stance, ball position, posture, pivot, weight shift, woods and irons full swing, rules and etiquette.

Through the Life skills we teach, your child will learn proper golf etiquette, how to introduce oneself when meeting other golfers, and other values such as resilience, self-confidence and goal—setting.

For children ages 9 and older, we offer 2-hour and 3-hour camps. For children 8 and under, the camps are limited to 90 and 60 minutes. Pricing for each camp varies, so please see the schedule on pages 7.

Ages 4-5 **Little Chippers**

A wonderful class for young children to learn about the very basics of golf including grip, stance & aim. We will be spending time on the putting green, chipping green and driving range—but most importantly we will be having lots of fun and learning some introductory life skills such as respect for the game of golf. Prizes are given for good behavior and for participating in contests. One parent/guardian in attendance is mandatory for the first lesson. Clubs available if needed.



Ages 5-6 & 7-8 **Bogey Level**

Introductory golf classes that emphasize fun! In these progressive classes, golf training focuses on the basics of grip, stance, posture, aim, putting, chipping, pitching, full swing (with woods and irons) and the basic rules and etiquette of golf. Life Skills focuses on honesty, respect and sports-manship. We will play fun games and drills to learn and enhance a desired golf motion and an emphasis on fundamentals and fun. Range balls, prizes, and clubs included.

Par Level: Ages 8-11 and 10-14



Golf training covers putting, chipping, pitching, grip, stance, ball position, posture, pivot, weight shift, woods & irons full swing and basic rules/etiquette. Par Core Values taught are honesty, respect and sportsmanship. Life Skills include how to introduce oneself, the importance of rules, staying cool on and off the golf course and how to maximize fun while learning something new. Juniors ages 8-9 will be put into Par Level 1, ages 10 plus will be put Par Level 2. Price includes golf prizes, bag tag, golf balls, range balls, tees, and use of golf clubs if needed.

Ages 6-10 and 11-14 LPGA Girls Golf

A nationally recognized program for girls interested in golf. The lessons include LPGA instruction, green fees, snacks, special events, prizes and range balls. Each player also receives a hat, bag tag & LPGA tee's & golf balls. Use of golf clubs if need.

Instruction covers putting, chipping, pitching, grip, stance, ball position, posture, pivot, weight shift, and full swing with woods and irons. Also, the basics on rules and etiquette.

Ages 9 and Up Junior PLAYer Leagues



Junior will play rounds on the course and receive instruction at the range.

The class includes instruction and course access at Highland 9-hole course. Golf balls will be provided for use on the golf course. Instruction includes putting, chipping, pitching, grip, stance, ball position, posture, pivot, weight shift, woods & iron full swing, golf course management and further details on rules and etiquette. Juniors will be grouped based on age and playing ability.

Monday Junior Leagues



The Junior League is played on an individual stroke play format. We emphasize having fun on the golf course while improving your golf skills, respecting the golf course and other golfers, and learning to to play a timely round of golf.

Juniors will receive a tee-time for the summer. They can request a tee-time to play with other Friends.

In August will have a free lunch provided for the juniors (For the past seven years, Fat Lorenzo's has provided the pizza.)

If your child is participating in the Monday Junior League, there is a mandatory open house orientation on Sunday, June 10, between 4 PM and 6 PM. Please stop by the Learning Center at the driving range at 1403 Montreal Ave for tee times, golf clubs buy/trade, range practice, and free golf balls/tees/wrist bands. You will also need to sign the league agreement form.
