How to Bid

- All guests will be assigned a bidder number at registration. That is your assigned number for <u>silent</u> and <u>live</u> items during the evening.
- Bid number card used only during the live auction. Memorize your bidder number for the silent part.
- Only registered bidders can participate in the auction process.
- The last bid at closing time constitutes the winning bid except if a guaranteed bid has already been placed on the item.
- Closing bids will be certified by an auction staff member.
- No bids can be entered after the section has closed.
- To bid on the live section, simply hold your bid number high until the auctioneer acknowledges your bid number.

Check Out

- Cash, Checks, MasterCard or Visa are the payment options allowed.
- <u>All sales are final and no exchanges or refunds will be honored on items except if specified.</u>
- When you check out you will receive a print out and copies of bid sheets on the items you won. Please use those bid sheets and your print out to collect your items you won at the end of the night.
- If you work for a company that participates in donation or fund matching, please mention this and forms will be provided for you to take home or fill out to help increase our auction profits.
- At time of checkout, please proceed to the cashiering desk. Please be patient as you wait to be helped. To curb our auction costs and increase the amount of money that stays with SBLC, we have chosen to not hire an auction company. This means that volunteers are in charge of running the checkout station! So please be patient with us.
- SBLC has made every effort to describe and catalog all items appropriately. All items are sold AS-IS. As buyer, you waive any claim to liability against SBLC, St. Michaels Catholic Church or the donor of the property or service sold.
- Most certificates are already in the baskets. If your item is a gift certificate, go to the cashier desk as they will have them.
- The amount of any contribution that is tax deductible is limited to the excess of any money over the value of the goods or services provided. Pleased consult your tax advisor for deductibility.

Silent Auction Rules

- Each item has a bid sheet. To make a bid, write your assigned bid number on the right side of the bid sheet next to the amount you want to bid. The bid amounts are pre-printed on the bid sheets. There will be an opening bid amount. You may skip lines to bid a higher amount at any time. Draw a line from the last bid number written to your new bid to help minimize invalid bids.
- Many items have a "Guaranteed Purchase Price" at the bottom of the bid sheet. At any time in the bidding, you may put your number next to that amount. That ends the bidding on that item and it is yours, even if the table is not closed yet.
- Upon announcement of a table closing, an auction volunteer will move everyone away from the table. The last bid written, or the guaranteed purchase price will be the winning bid. Tables will not reopen after closing.

Live Auction Rules

- To bid on an item during the live auction, hold up your bidding number.
- The highest bidder acknowledged by the auctioneer wins the item and agrees to pay the bid amount to SBLC in exchange for the item.
- A general description of live auction items can be found in this catalog. Please note any restrictions limitations, and/or conditions.

Dessert Dash– It's as Easy as 1...2...3!

Who says you can't have dessert first? If you are the highest bidding table, you get the prime position of choosing any dessert you want! Here's all you have to do:

- 1. Check out the delicacies and assorted confections showcased at the Dessert Auction tables in the middle of the banquet hall. Just look for the sparkly red table!
- 2. Gather your tablemates and place your bids on the dessert auction sheet located at your table. Your combined bids will determine the order of how the desserts are chosen. The sheets are tallied and then the highest table goes first. Each table gets to choose from the remaining available desserts on their turn. Before the live auction begins, our volunteers will be coming around to collect the bid sheet.

Hint 1: Bid high to insure your table receives the dessert of your choice.

Hint 2: Choose a table captain that is ready to sprint to the dessert winner finish line and be ready with your top three choices.

3. Our auctioneer will announce the order starting with the highest bidder. When it's your tables turn, you'll dash over and pick your desired dessert (see Hint 2). You may take your dessert back to your table with you.
