4. a) Players requesting a registration fee refund shall be given the refund on the following basis:
Prior to February 1st - refund pro-rated on a monthly basis (or portion thereof).
After February 1st - No refund. (All refunds are less the cost of Hockey Manitoba card).
- b) No refunds for any players under suspension from The Pas Minor Hockey Association.
- c) No refunds will be approved unless request is made in writing and mailed to TPMHA or hand delivered to the treasurer or president

PROPOSED WORDING:

4. Refunds will be granted according to the date the request in writing has been received by the Treasurer or President and following the table below. Note: Hockey Manitoba, Hockey Canada, and NORMAN fees are non-refundable if fees have been paid. If not paid, 100% refund of associated fees.
 - September 1 to 30 - 80% refund
 - October 1 to 31 - 75% refund
 - November 1 to 30 - 50% refund
 - December 1 to 31 - 25% refund

After January 1st, not refund will be granted. Note fees refunded exclude raffle tickets or any TPMHA raffle costs. These tickets/raffle cost stay remain with the family.

RATIONALE FOR CHANGE:

Easier to calculate refunds.
