

BBFSC Volunteer Hours and Opportunities

Starting July 1st and ending June 30th of each year, each skater needs to complete 5 hours of volunteer for the club. Opportunities for volunteer hours are signing up to do the following:

1. **Ice Monitor** at open ice times will sit in the music box to play music as skaters need and watch for injuries.
2. **Parade** – Organize for the Potato Bowl Parade by filling out the registration form and sending it in, finding 4 parent volunteers and skaters to participate in walking/roller blading through the parade route throwing candy, and purchase the candy. (1 hour of volunteer hours for each skater participating).
3. **Test Session** – Announcing at test session and playing music, Paperwork – making photocopies of results sheets, writing down results and delivering paperwork to coaches, set up and tear down, driving the judges and dance partner to and from airport and hotels to the rink and picking up their dinner.
4. **Ice Show Committee** – Organizing the groups, getting senior flowers and coach's gifts.
5. **Exhibition** - Ice Monitor: ensuring the correct skaters are checked in and allowing them to get on and off the ice, announcing and playing music.
