Right before our Open House this evening I received the unfortunate news from our administration that several of our players are being forced to quarantine due to potential exposure to a student who has tested positive for COVID-19. I am not allowed to name the student or our players who have to quarantine but I can tell you that it was NOT a football player who tested positive. Rather, one of our students came to school on Monday before developing symptoms on Tuesday (not at school), got tested, and received the positive results today (or at least notified our administration today). Our administration went through the seating charts of every class that this student was in on Monday in order to determine which students would have to quarantine. While it is incredibly unfortunate and disappointing that several of our players have to stay home this week (and until Monday or Tuesday of next week depending on the exposure) it is better than having to shut down entire classrooms or even the whole school.

Our scheduled game at Lake Country Lutheran is still on for the moment but the number of players we will be missing puts that game in serious jeopardy. We will be exploring our options tonight and tomorrow and I will keep you all informed as I learn more.

While I am extremely frustrated and disappointed right now, please know that we will get through this and that we will fight to give our guys the opportunity to finish the season on the field like they should. Players, know that I love you and I'm here for you. If you need someone to talk to, call or text me any time. Parents, if you have questions or concerns, I'll do my best to answer them or I'll ask our administrators for help and/or clarification
