

2019 High School BOYS Player Registration Information

Please read the following PRIOR to beginning the registration process:

Eligibility Requirements: To play lacrosse for a Waukesha High School Lacrosse team, the player must attend:

High School BOYS: Waukesha North HS, Waukesha South HS or Waukesha West HS.

Athlete Eligibility "Card": All High School Players must meet the required athlete eligibility requirements at their respective High School. **It is the responsibility of the High School player to complete their high school's spring sport registration and obtain their athletic card from their High School's Athletic Department PRIOR to the first tryout practice.**

US Lacrosse Membership: An annual US Lacrosse Membership is required to participate. There is an annual non-refundable fee payable to US Lacrosse for this membership.

A US Lacrosse membership valid through August 31, 2019 will be required PRIOR to REGISTRATION for ALL players.

You must register with US Lacrosse PRIOR to completing player registration. To obtain a new US Lacrosse Membership or renew a US Lacrosse Membership, please follow these steps:

- **IF YOU DO NOT HAVE A CURRENT US LACROSSE MEMBERSHIP:** [CLICK HERE](#) to go to US Lacrosse Registration and register your player(s). Be sure to PRINT and SAVE their confirmation code(s). Remember to register EACH of your players with US Lacrosse. Each player must have their own unique US Lacrosse confirmation number.
- **TO LOOK UP/RENEW A US LACROSSE MEMBERSHIP:** [CLICK HERE](#) to go to US Lacrosse Membership Lookup.
 - US Lacrosse will ask if you are registering your son or daughter as a Player, Coach or Official. Select: **PLAYER**
 - US Lacrosse will ask to designate the Primary Club/Program
 - Select **WISCONSIN** in the first drop down box for the state
 - Enter **WAUKESHA** in the search box. **Select ONE of the following:**

You will be asked to enter the US Lacrosse Membership No. for each player as part of the registration process.

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Player Fee (High School Boys):

EARLY FEE - Register before January 15, 2019: \$400

REGULAR FEE - Register on or after January 16, 2019: \$500

Due Upon Registration: \$ 75 non-refundable deposit

Balance Due on or before March 1, 2019: \$325 (Early) or \$425 (Regular)

Total Registration Player Fee: \$400 (Early) or \$500 (Regular)

2019 Season Player fees and any prior year outstanding balances must be paid PRIOR to March 1, 2019 or participation in tryouts, practices and/or games for the 2019 Season.

Credit Card Payments:

You may choose to pay your player's fee by credit card in full at time of registration or with the following credit card payment plan. Please note, the dates are fixed, and the system does not adjust dates automatically based on the date someone registers. Credit card payments will be AUTOMATICALLY charged to your credit card on the dates in the following payment schedule. The same account entered at the time of registration will be charged on the following dates.

Payment Schedule: Credit Card Payments will be AUTOMATICALLY charged to your card on the following dates:

Payment 1: \$ 75 Due Upon Registration

Payment 2: \$162.50 (Early Fee) or \$212.50 (Regular Fee) Due February 1, 2019

Payment 3: \$162.50 (Early Fee) or \$212.50 (Regular) Due March 1, 2019

Balance Due: March 1, 2019

Check Payments: Check payments will still be accepted and can be mailed to the Treasurer according to the above Payment Schedule. (Treasurer address will be provided in registration receipt.)

Player Refunds:

On or Before March 1, 2019 players can receive a refund less the NON-REFUNDABLE Deposit of \$75.

After March 1, 2019 NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN.

Refund requests must be made in writing and received by the High School Boys Director on or prior to March 1, 2019.

("REGSAVER" Registration Insurance: Regsaver provides reimbursement for non-refundable athlete registration fees in case of injury, illness, job layoff, military leave, and more. Regsaver is offered by Sports Engine in partnership with AIG, .Regsaver is an OPTIONAL insurance product that will be offered on the checkout page of registration. This is available for those paying their registration fees by credit card. The cost is 7% of the total Player Fee or a minimum of \$7. [CLICK HERE](#) for more information from REGSAVER. This is NOT a Waukesha Lacrosse Club product.)

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2019 Volunteer Fee:

The Waukesha Lacrosse Club, Inc. is a non-profit organization which is run by Volunteers.

A \$200.00/Player or \$500/Family Maximum Volunteer Fee will be charged to each family for the 2019 season.

Player 1: \$200 Oldest Player (Must fulfill the number of credits for this player's team)
Player 2: \$200 Youngest Player (Must fulfill the number of credits for this player's team)
Player 3: \$100 Remaining Players (Credits obligations are fulfilled for Players 1 & 2.)

A **separate** check dated **June 1, 2019** and made payable to WLC is required at the time of registration and prior to your player's to participation in any tryouts, practices or games.

If volunteer obligations are fulfilled for the 2019 Season, your check is destroyed. If volunteer obligations are NOT fulfilled for the 2019 Season, your check is cashed at the end of the season.

Required Equipment:

High School Boys: Helmet, shoulder pads, elbow pads, gloves, boys lacrosse stick -shaft and head, mouth guard and a protective cup.

NOTE: Boys HS players will be provided team issued helmets to use during the season.

Team provided uniforms and equipment:

Each player will receive a uniform and other team issued items (examples may include: game jersey(s), game shorts, practice jersey/pinnies, warm ups, helmets-, etc.).

The team issued items will be signed out to each individual player. All items are required to be returned in good condition on the date specified by the program director or other designated person.

A fee will be charged to the player's parent(s)/guardian(s) for any item(s) not returned or are returned damaged. Replacement costs are based upon manufactured pricing and minimum order requirements.

High School Player Student Accounts with the Waukesha School District may be charged for uncollected player fees, payments, or other charges such as equipment not returned or returned damaged.

Returned/Non-Sufficient Funds Fee: A returned check/non-sufficient funds fee of \$25 will be charged to the player's parent(s)/guardian(s) for any payment returned for non-sufficient funds or due to a stop payment. All outstanding balances are due prior to further participation.
