OUR WRESTLING TEAM MET AGAIN AND DEVELOPED A NEW MISSION STATEMENT FOR 1998-1999.

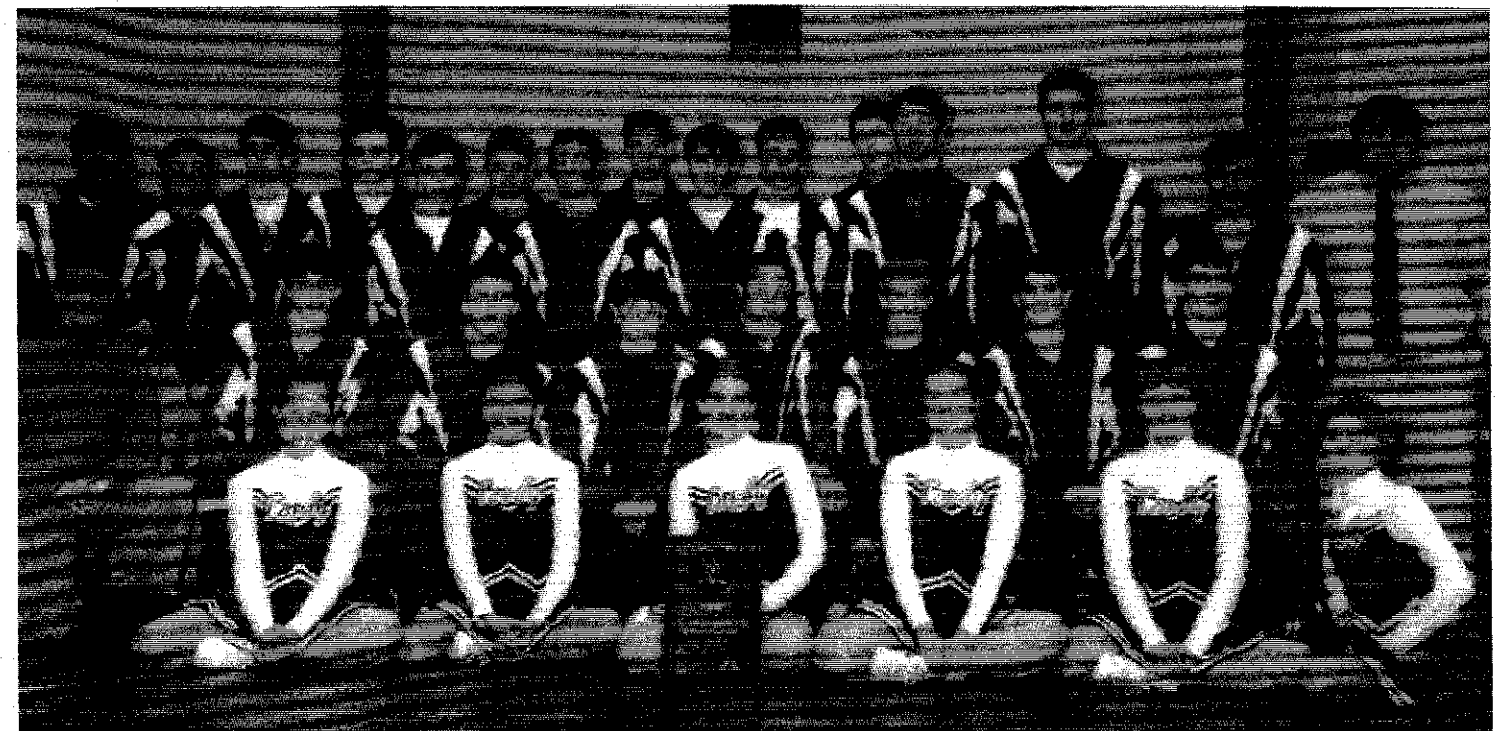

Cardinals finish No. 2 in state

Wis. Rapids claims 4th straight title

WEST ALLIS — Goodrich High School wrestling coach Larry Marchionda has always shunned the personal spotlight, trying instead to focus attention on the competitors under his command.

So it isn't surprising that the 30-year Cardinal coach, who has made no secret that he is considering retirement after this season, wasn't about to let questions about his future interfere with the present.

He wanted only to soak in the emotions after watching his team culminate its season Saturday night with a runner-up finish at the WIAA Division I State Team Tournament.

"This is the kids' year and it has been and should continue to be because they have done so much," he said after the Cardinals dropped a 38-16 decision to Wisconsin Rapids, which won its fourth consecutive state crown.

"Every young man on this team fits in the mold of the tradition of Fond du Lac wrestling. They're dedicated, hard-working and deserve all the accolades they're get-

ting."

WEST ALLIS — Goodrich High School senior Scott Gustin is already hearing footsteps after setting a new Cardinal record for career victories Saturday morning at the WIAA Wrestling Tournament.

NOTEBOOK

Gustin beat Tom Lennon of Portage 10-6 at 130 pounds to help spearhead a 36-15 win over the Warriors which earned the No. 5 Cardinals a berth in Saturday Night's Division I championship match against top-ranked Wisconsin Rapids.

The win gave the third-place individual state placefinisher a four-year 135-26 mark, surpassing Court Gifford's 134-26 record from 1989-92.

He also became the first Cardinal to reach 40 victories in a season Friday when he won by technical fall over Waukesha South's Adam Douglas in the quarterfinals. His season record stood at 41-3 entering Saturday's final against the Red Raiders.

"It means I've had four years of consistency," he said of the career record. "It'll cap off my my whole career. Wins are the thing that count and it's nice to know I can come out with the most wins in our school."

However, Gustin doesn't expect to hold the record for long.

He predicted Saturday that freshman teammate Jacob Huemphreys will eventually take away his mark. A third-place 117-pound placefinisher at State, Huemphreys was 39/7 through Saturday morning.

"In a couple of years when Jacob Huemphreys is a senior I'm pretty sure he'll get a good chance at breaking it," Gustin said. "I guess I'll be up on the record board for a while, but I don't think it's going to last very long."

Fondy sets sights on state crown

Card grapplers lead Division 1 with 19-0 mark

When the WIAA first instituted its state team tournament in 1992, most wrestling fans considered it an afterthought, a little brother to the organization's hugely popular individual tourney.

In the intervening six years, however, the team event has grown in both acceptance and popularity.

Last year the tournament set a record straight attendance record with 6,647 spectators and Fond du Lac coach Larry Marchionda is expected about a return to the event with West Allis Central High School.

The Cardinals have qualified for the fifth time in the seven-year history of the tournament with a school record and Division I-best team dual meet record. Fond du Lac, which won the last state tournament in 1991, opened their final action Friday night when Waukesha South (18-2) won. Marchionda said of the team, "Maybe I shouldn't say that, but they achieve to, and they have abilities. That is due to the 1991 record is the best in school history," he continued.

Things like that don't happen without leadership from within. I think credit for that should go to the upperclassmen and the entire team. Coaches can suggest, and prepare under the team train-

ances, falling to eventual champion Merrill in 1992 and '93 and to runner-up River Falls in 1996. Last year Hartford rallied to win the final three matches and beat the Cardinals 26-23. Marchionda said he has learned from the losses and about how to prepare under the team train-

3 Fondy grapplers battle into semis

MADISON — Goodrich High School wrestlers are spitting out the word "focus" so often at the WIAA State Tournament that they're starting to sound like camera salesmen.

But their almost-obsessive attention to coach Larry Marchionda's take-it-one-match-at-a-time philosophy is paying off.

The Cardinals' five state qualifiers won seven of nine matches Thursday night as Fond du Lac advanced three competitors — freshman 112-pounder Jacob Huempfer and seniors Ikuhiro Yanagawa (125) and Scott Gustin (130) — into tonight's Division I semifinals at the University of Wisconsin's new Kohl Center.

"I think I'm more focused than other years," said Gustin, a three-time state qualifier and fourth-place finisher last year. "I'm just focusing on the guy ahead of me and it's working out."

"I was really focused," said the rookie Huempfer. "We've been

working all week preparing ourselves for down here. I pretty much knew what to expect." That is music to Marchionda's ears.

"They're very well-prepared, very focused," he said. "They work hard all of the time. They know what they have to do: take one match at a time and accept the results."

Brad Casetta (145) easily won his first match, but fell 5-3 to top-rated Billy Thompson of Sun Prairie in the quarterfinals, while fellow sophomore Jake Eigenbrodt (135) lost his opener. Both remain active in wrestleback action.

Yanagawa was perhaps the Cardinals' biggest surprise.

"Iku has been stepping up in practice," Marchionda said following Yanagawa's 8-4 quarterfinal win over Alex Nelson of Portage. "He's been picking up the intensity. His practices are more intense and you can see it out here."

Gustin said he wanted to use his first match — a 7-3 win over Wau-

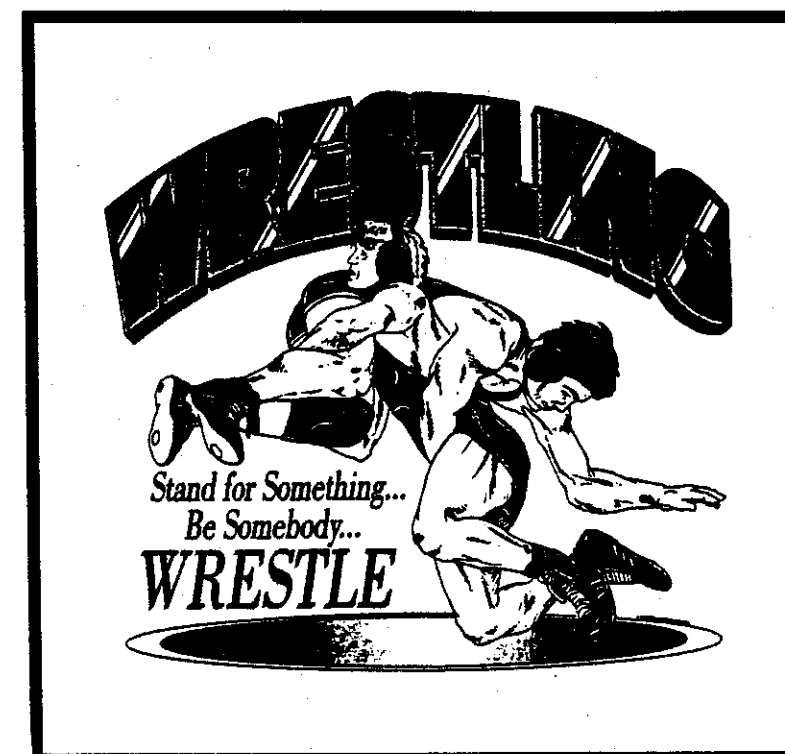

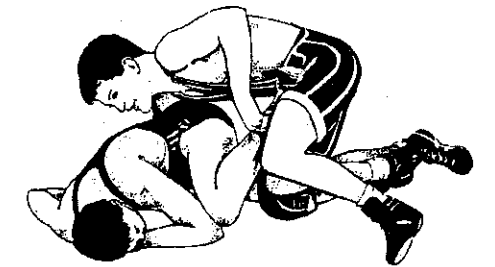

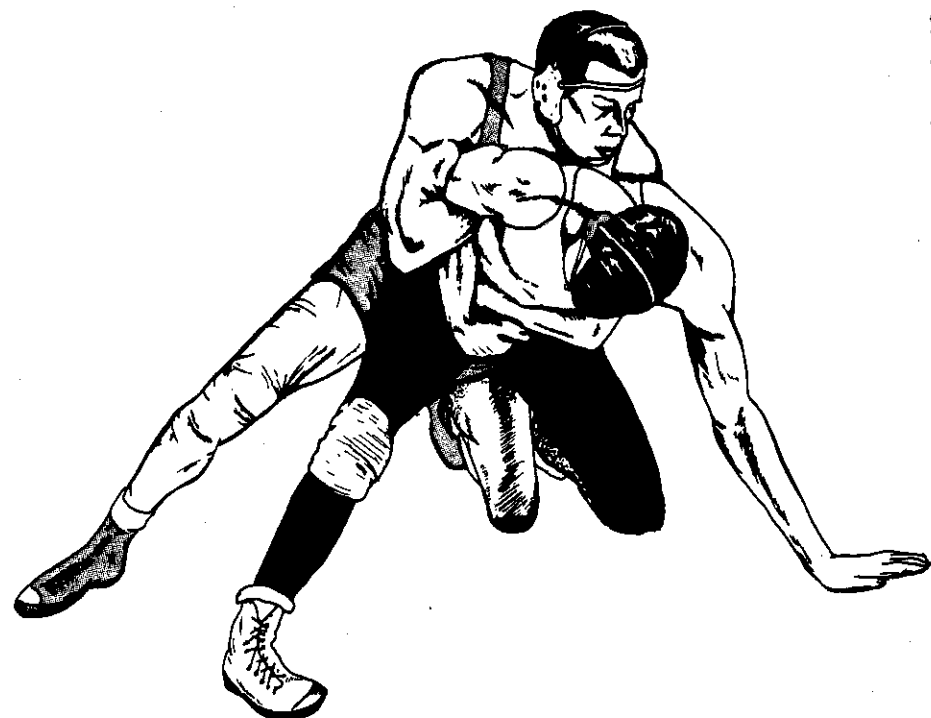
