General Information

- The doors will open at 7:20 am. First games start at 8:00 am.
- All coaches must check in at the Directors' Table when they arrive, located in the hallway outside of all 3 gyms (by the Fieldhouse Entrance)
- Team camps will be assigned for each team. Please camp in your team's area. No team camps in the commons, on tables, or in the gyms.
- Concessions is available. NO outside food or fast food allowed. We will check bags if needed. Please support our club. **(CASH ONLY)**

Play Rules

- Pool Play starts at 8:00 am
- For each team's first match, warm ups will be 10 minutes, 2 shared-4 serving team-4 receiving team
- Remaining matches (including playoffs) will be 5 minutes, 1 shared-2 serving team-2 receiving team
- Teams must serve during their court time. When it is the other team's time on the court, there is no ball handling on the side or back by the off team. Please help the team on the court shag or protect the other courts from stray volleyballs.
- Teams will stay on the same side
- Warm up balls will NOT be provided. A game ball will be provided at each court.
- Pool Play matches are 2 sets to 25, no cap. Playoffs are 2 out of 3 sets 3rd to 15, no cap
- 1st and 2nd Place teams from each pool will play in the Gold Division (Court 1)
- 3rd and 4th Place teams from each pool will play in the Silver Division (Court 2)
- A coach must be either the up or the down ref. All teams will be responsible for officiating matches. Teams must provide all personal up ref, down ref, line judges, scoreboard, scorebook, and libero tracker. The players need to pay attention to the game. No cell phones or other distractions at the table.
