Parking Protocol for Softball Tournament in Woburn

I know most of the teams are not from this area so I want to go over our Parking rules for the 3 fields that you will be visiting for the Softball Tournament being held on May $10^{th} - 12^{th}$. Below are some parking protocols for the tournament for you to review. Please do not park on any grass area and do not park where there are orange saw horses put into place!

Library Field (Across the Street from the Police Station on Harrison Avenue)

- There are 3 parking lots you may use to park for this field
 - 1 small lot to the left of the Police Station (Do not park in the lot directly in front of the Police Station)
 - 1 Lot behind the upper field that extends up to the Library
 - Municipal Lot at City Hall (Go all the way past the Library so it is on your left and you will see it next to the Court House)
- You may park on Harrison Avenue or on North Warren Street but Please DO NOT BLOCK DRIVEWAYS!
- Under NO CIRCUMSTANCES ARE YOU ABLE TO PARK ON THE FIELD AT ALL! Only authorized City Vehicles are allowed on the field.

Gonsalves Field (South Bedford Street)

- You may park in the lower parking lot and also use the dirt area that extends up to the field (Do not park up on field next to snack shack).
- You may park on the Field Side of South Bedford Street. Do not park at the end of the field side past the telephone pole were there are 3 NO Parking signs you will block 2 driveways if you do.
- You may park in the Joyce Middle School Parking Lot (55 Locust Street) or on the main roads.
- **Do not park** on Jaycin Circle
- **Do not park** on the grass areas near the Tennis & Basketball Court! I don't think you would want anyone parking on your grass at your home!
- Do not block driveways!

Veterans Field (144 School Street)

- You may use the parking lot in the front of the Senior Center
- Do not park cars out back of the senior center this is for authorized vehicles only

Please respect our fields and facilities by picking up all of your trash! We do not allow dogs at our fields so please make arrangements to leave them at home!

We also <u>do not allow</u> Soft toss at Gonsalves Field at all and you may do soft toss at Library Field & Veterans field into nets you bring away from the field area near the Tennis Courts. No soft toss into our fences please.

Drinking Alcohol at any of our fields is not allowed and this will be closely monitored by the Woburn Police Department.
