Player Fees



Grades 3-7: \$180.00 per participant - FEE \$130 + HOOPS MANIA \$50

Grade 8: 305.00 per participant - FEE \$130 + HOOPS MANIA \$50 plus \$125.00 deposit for uniform and volunteer hours

These fees cover approximately 1/2 of the cost of your child playing in tournaments. The other 1/2 comes from money we make through fundraising.



Deposit Checks



GRADE 8 ONLY

You are required to write a check for \$305.00 which will be cashed. This price is in lieu of us holding a check of \$125 for the entire year. We will have a turn in date in April where you will receive a refund if applicable.

After the season is complete, money will be returned if:

- Volunteer hours are satisfied
- Uniform is returned cleaned and in good condition

Wisconsin Youth Basketball League



- WYBL--**
- *Boys "A" Level Teams Grades 6-8**
 - *League begins early November**
 - *2 Games are played every other Sunday**
 - 16 League Games will end Late February**
 - League championship will be early March**
 - *ALL of our games will be away**
 - *Team Rosters are due later October**

TRYOUTS for players interested in playing in this league will take place at each level and scheduled at a later date



Wisconsin Youth Basketball League

WYBL league will count for 5 tournaments of the total tournaments the team is allowed

Players/Teams not interested in this league will still have a team to play with and tournaments to play

LBL league will count for 3 tournaments of the total tournaments the team is allowed

Teams not in LBL will play their full slate of tournaments

Grades 3-4 up to 8 tournaments

Grades 5-8 up to 10 tournaments



Team Philosophy



Teams at each Grade Level:

- Teams Grades 3-5 will be split evenly
- Teams Grades 6-8 will be created based on Skill Level

- Players of similar skill will play together and coaches will enter the team in tournaments that most closely match skill level.

WE NEED PARENTS / VOLUNTEERS TO COACH

Each Coach will schedule their own tournaments and coach the games



PLAYER PRIORITIES



1. **FAMILY first:** Respect your parents/guardians and tell them you love them for letting you play basketball
2. **SCHOOL:** Your education is what will take you places.

SCHOOL ACCOUNTABILITY FORMS:

- a. ALL players are required to get signatures from ALL teachers every week
 - b. Teachers will let us know of missing work or poor behavior
 - c. Form not turned in or chronic (more than once) poor choices will result in lost playing time
Playing time will decrease with each successive miscue
 - D. Form is on Youth Basketball website and the middle schools also have the forms in the office
3. **BASKETBALL:** During the basketball season



Playing Time



Grades 3-5 - All players will get similar playing time

Grades 6-8 - Playing time will be earned

TOP FACTORS TO DETERMINE PLAYING TIME:

EFFORT ATTITUDE COACHABILITY ATTENDANCE

Basketball skill and knowledge are considered after the above criteria have been met.
