



MASK EXCEPTION COVID-19 GUIDELINES

At Alodia Basketball Academy, we are 100% committed to providing a safe environment for ALL players, spectators, and staff.

Everyone must do their part to maintain a worry-free experience and help us keep everyone safe and healthy and keep children doing what they do best – playing!

MASKS ARE REQUIRED for everyone not on the court participating as a player, coach, or referee.

Please read below and as posted on our website for those individuals with medical conditions that prevent them from wearing a mask (this includes spectators, players, coaches, and referees and all attending):

1. Alodia requires that the individuals share physical or electronic documentation from a medical doctor **24 hours prior to the Alodia event** outlining the exception for the person.
2. Once the documentation is approved and communicated to the individual, Alodia will have the individual on an exception list at the event.
3. The person upon entry must acknowledge their inclusion on this list and show valid proof of identity (driver's license).
4. The individual will then receive a separate wrist band to wear identifying them as having a documented medical exception.
5. Once allowed into the event, the individual must comply with all other event rules: social distancing, avoiding standing in common areas, and following the event code of conduct.

This process allows us to be in compliance with Governor Greg Abbott's order, HIPAA, and OSHA.
