

Varsity Overview

Tonight is a farewell to another great wrestling season, and a good – bye to 7 special Senior Wrestlers, along with 3 awesome stat girls. The 2021-22 wrestling team did not take a back seat to anyone. All of the obstacles that this team faced, didn't deter them from having an outstanding season. Covid, definitely took a toll on the normalness of our season. But our moto was "No Excuses", and when somebody had to sit out, somebody else stepped up and got the job done. Although difficult to handle, it was actually special to watch unfold. Our coaching staff grinded just like the wrestlers in continuing to let our wrestlers see the needed competition that was important in their development. In this manner, the 2021-22 team had a total of 26 letters earned, as we found Varsity competition for so many. With all of these men wrestling the team ended with a very solid 26-7 record. The Varsity was crowned Southwest Conference Champions for the 11th year in a row, and also winning the Columbia Hickman tournament and Regional Championship. So many hours of training, and a great balance of seniors and underclassmen helped us reach our goals. Although we fell a little short of our team goals, losing by 2 points last Tuesday to a very solid Moline squad, the effort that the team showed was truly second to none. Tuesday was seemingly just not meant for us, but everybody who participated and all those who prepared for it, can hold their heads high as effort and attitude was right on.

This season was also the implementation of the brand new – Edwardsville High School Girls Wrestling Program. So new, but so enjoyable to see these girls give the effort, branch out to something new, and experience the highs and lows of what wrestling or any other sport has to offer. We had 10 girls complete the season this year, and hope to add to this total even more next season. Although our program was new, and didn't consist of all the dual meets like the boys, we were able to be involved in three tournaments. The girls placed a remarkable 3rd out of 16 teams in their first event – The Lady Longhorn Round – up. We also participated in the largest event – the Wonder woman in Columbia, Mo. The girls placed 43 out of 77 teams, with Abby Rhodes placing 4th. The last tournament was at Columbia Hickman where we placed 6th out of 13. Mackenzie Pratt and Olivia Coll brought home Championships. The grand Finale – State tournament was just an awesome experience – seeing all three girls bring home state medals. Mackenzie was our first state finalist, and Abby came home with 3rd and Olivia receive a 6th. More work to do, to get even better next year.

So what took place to propel another great season? It was hard work. To be able to work hard, fight off your back, wrestler sore, make weight, lose multiple times, come back after a covid set back – puts you into a special group – TIGER WRESTLERS. The attributes not only helped you this season, but can help you for a lifetime. Wrestlers - thanks for a great season.

Stat girls - thanks for all of you countless help during the season, helping us accomplish what we did. The value that we share for you is countless. This program alone, would not happen without you. Thanks you so much on behalf of all the coaches and wrestlers.

This year's seniors' were short in numbers, but not effort. They will not leave many holes in the line – up – but they will be big holes. The conference is getting sick of us winning, and will place another target on our back, like many of the teams did this year. Getting to the top is tough, but staying there is even more of a challenge. We have many returning letterman, along with undefeated j.v. and freshman teams. But this does not guarantee wins. It will continue to take hard work and dedication, which is what wrestling, is all about. We have a little bad taste of the loss to Moline. Let's dedicate to have the feeling we felt last Tuesday in our last match – be a feeling we don't want. Let's work so we don't have to feel that way again. Wrestlers, Parents, Coaches, Fans – let's see how high we can turn up the efforts to reach elite levels. If we don't make it, the journey will all be worth it.

Seniors – thanks again for a great career. We wish you the best in your future endeavors. 


