Rule changes for Fall 2024

- NO slide tackling prior to 7/8 grade teams and above
- Team captain must be identified on field via captain's armband for grade 3 and up
- Competition Rule replaces Mercy Rule
 - When a team is down by 4 goals, they may add an additional player
 - For each 4-goal differential an additional player may be added
 - If the losing team does not have additional players to add when they have a 4-goal differential, then the winning team must remove a player from the field
 - This does not apply to teams playing in inter-city leagues
- Substitutions may be made on any restart when the ball is out of play.

Role of Coach

- Only 1 head coach and others are assistants.
- People must register to coach and to receive the coaching discount.
- Coaches cannot add people to their rosters – child/coach.
- Coaches cannot reschedule games.
- Coaches should hold at a minimum 1 practice per week.
- Coach should model appropriate behavior.
- Coach is responsible for managing the parents on the sidelines.
- Coaches must remain between the 18 yard markers
- Home team coach chooses which side of the field to sit on

Role of Coach (con't)

- Coaches must remain between the goal areas
- Home team coach chooses which side of the field to sit on
- Home team is responsible to bring nets/flags to field for first game of day and to return neys/flags atfter last game of the day
- Each coach should setup/takedown one of the nets

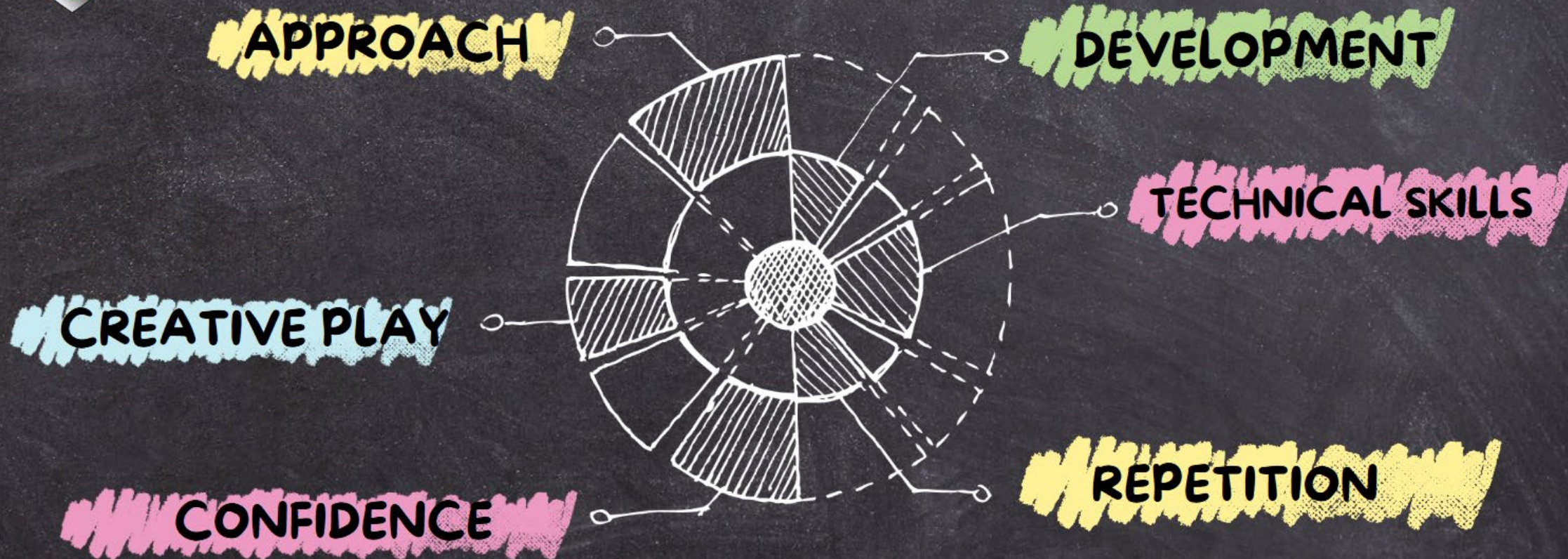

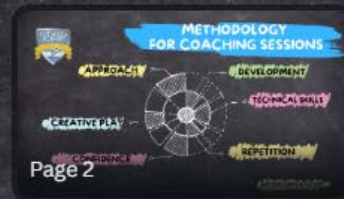
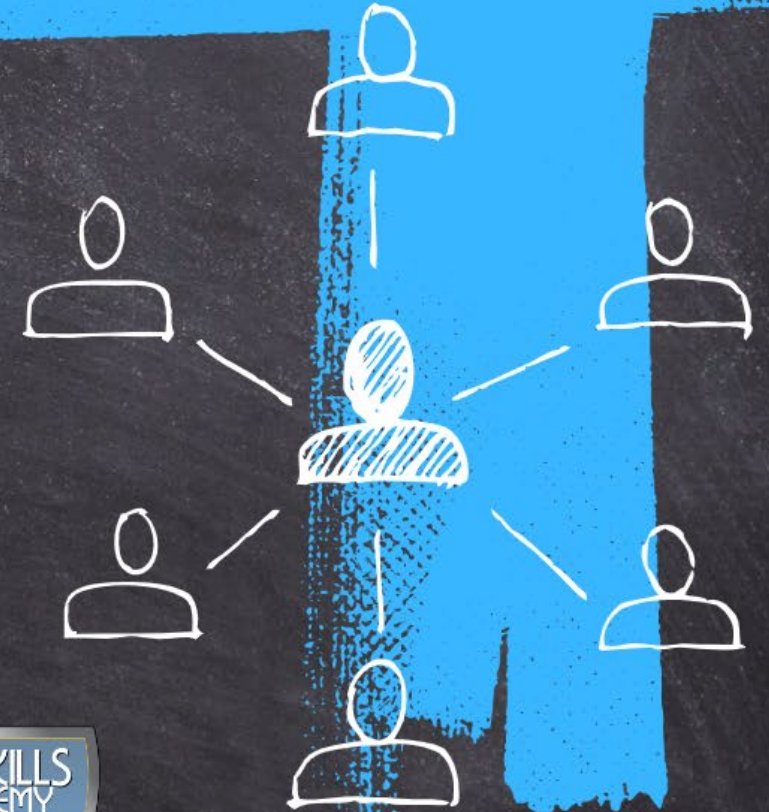

Referees for Fall 2024

- Do not argue with the referee.
- Per LOTG entering the field without permission is a red card offense.
- **No jewelry** of any type is permitted on players (girls & boys) during practices and/or games. This includes anything on the wrist, neck or ears. Earrings not allowed.
- Covering ears with tape or band-aids does not make earrings safe and is **NOT** permitted.
- Wrapped cast in bubble wrap or padding may be permitted.
- Medical alert bracelets and religious objects may be worn as long as they are secured (nothing loose; no gaps).

Player Equipment

- All players must have cleats and shin guards
- Shin guards must be fully covered by socks
- Cold weather gear may be allowed at the discretion of the referee
- TYSL Jersey must be worn on outside and clearly visible

Weather Policy

- In case of severe weather refer to the TYSL website (tysl.info) to see if all League games are cancelled.
- Target to post at 3:00 PM on weekdays, 9:00 AM Friday night for Saturday games and 10:00 AM on Sunday for Sunday games.
- Unless the League posts a game cancellation you should report to the field at appropriate game time. Game time cancellations at the field will be at the referee's discretion.

Team Formation Process

- Teams are formed based on where you live (square mile)
- Teams are reformed in Fall as the players grade changes
- Teams in multi-grade divisions(5/6 and 7/8) are balanced across grade level as well
- Travel player registration was also considered in team formation
- Roster size does impact team formation
- Registration date (late registration) can impact where you are placed

TYSL 50th Anniversary

- Held a design contest with Middle School and High School students
- Board ranked designs
- Awarded prize to top three designs and honorable mention at Troy Historic Village open house
- Shirts will be distributed to each team within the first two weeks of the season
- Coaches need to provide office with list of players and shirt size – by packet pickup if possible
