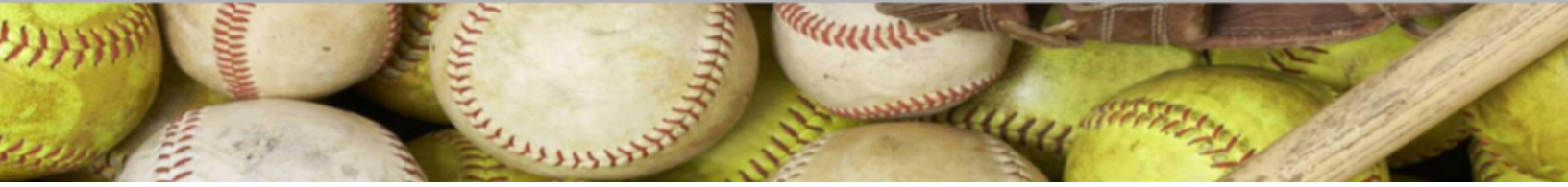


OSHKOSH YOUTH BASEBALL/SOFTBALL



Spring Training Camps 2019

The YMCA is once again sponsoring spring training camp for potential youth baseball/softball players. The purpose of this camp is to provide young players with an opportunity to throw, field, and swing a bat during a time of the year when developing baseball skills may not be a priority. Due to the number of available gym times and the number of kids participating, the majority of the time will be spent in drills designed to get as many repetitions as possible on the basic skills during the available time.

This day is set aside for 9 – 12 year old baseball/softball pitchers and catchers to get preseason work. Players will be given instruction and different drills to improve their skills. Handouts will be provided.

Catchers should try have their own equipment if possible. Athletic cup is required for male catchers.

What to bring: All players should have dry gym shoes, and a glove. Bring bats and helmets if you have them. Do not bring a baseball/softball. Baseballs/softballs will be provided.

Parents and Potential Coaches Responsibility: You are encouraged to help out if you like. Oshkosh West baseball/softball players will also be there to assist at camp stations.
