Reminder that returning players will be using their batting helmet and jerseys from the previous year and enter "N/A" in the batting helmet size and jersey size fields when registering unless new jerseys or a helmet are needed because of growth or excessive wear (e.g., catchers equipment causing damage).

### **\*\*Deadline to register is May 1, 2024\*\***

Early registration is encouraged to help determine the number of teams, coaching needs, equipment needs, and the uniform order including sizing.

If a player does not make a team, their \$50 tryout fee will be refunded in full.

**WHAT AGE IS ELIGIBLE?** Players must be 13 years of age as of January 1, 2024 to be eligible for the Junior Legion Baseball program. If a player was born in 2005 or 2006, that player must play for the Senior Legion Baseball program. \*\*Players that graduated from high school in 2023 shall play for the last American Legion team they played on. Players shall not be eligible for transfer and their name must appear on a previously approved Legion roster. Players born in 2004 or before are no longer eligible to play American Legion Baseball.

### **DOES MY ZIP CODE DETERMINE MY LEGION TEAM ELIGIBILITY?**

The American Legion Baseball player to Legion team commitment is determined by the shortest driving distance from the player's home residence to the Legion team's home field. If a player is cut from one team, they can try out for the next closest Legion team. If a player wishes to play for another Legion team (see the eligibility terms below), they must get a release waiver signed from their local Legion team director.

### ***Point/Plover/Surrounding Communities (amended 2009 to present day:***

- **Must play for Stevens Point if you live in** Stevens Point 54481, Junction City 54443, or Rosholt 54473
- **Must play for Plover if you live in the** Village of Plover 54467 or Amherst 54406
- **Have your choice to play wherever if you live in** Whiting 54481, Park Ridge 54481, Town of Hull 54481, Town of Plover 54481, Custer 54423, Stockton 54481, Amherst Junction 54407, Polonia 54423, or Stevens Point 54482.
- **The following areas can play with closer Legion Team, if you live in** Plainfield, Almond, Bancroft (Waushara County)
