 - DIBS requirement is 5 hours per child registered for Travel (3 hours for Rec registrants); exception for coaches, team manager, and for families that chose the "buyout option" at registration.
- How can I fulfill these hours?
 - Log into the DIBS system from the PWYSA Website, sign up for open opportunities.

 - Sign up early to get the times that best meet your schedule
- What if I cannot fulfill my hours?

 - Practice days will vary from standard M/W & T/Th schedule


Outdoor Practices


