

CODE OF CONDUCT

Greenville Youth Sports Griffins Tournament Baseball Teams Players and Parents/Guardians

The purpose of this document is to ensure that all players and parents/guardians of players participating in the GYS Griffins Tournament Baseball are aware of the Code of Conduct. GYS will not tolerate hostile and disruptive behavior by its coaches, parents, or players. Failure to observe the Code of Conduct could result in forfeiture of your son's tournament participation as well as their continued participation in our program for future events.

Parents

- I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care, and encouragement for my son's participation in Griffins baseball.
- I will remember that my son's game of baseball is for kids – not adults.
- I will help my son enjoy his Griffins baseball experience by doing whatever I can to be a respectful fan and to make the sport of baseball fun for my son.
- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches and officials at every game and practice.
- I will support Griffins coaches and officials working with my child, in-order-to encourage a positive and enjoyable baseball experience for all involved.
- As a parent and fan, I will not harass, abuse, disrespect or cause a disturbance against an opposing coach, player or official.
- I will treat all players, coaches, fans, and officials with respect.
- I understand that my son's team is a competitive tournament baseball team and playing time for all players is not guaranteed at any time.
- I understand that I'm required to fulfill an additional 2 hours of volunteer hours for our Greenville home tournament my son's team plays at. Failure to complete these volunteer hours will result in an additional fee of \$100 per hour unfulfilled. We need your help to make our hosting tournaments successful. NOTE: This is separate to league volunteer hour requirements.
