# Sunday May 28, 2023 Scripture Readings June 4: Ex 34:4b-6, 8-9, 2 Cor 13:11-13, Jn 3:16-18 (164)

**Pastor's Message** The Feast of Pentecost (the gift of the Holy Spirit) celebrates the "birth" of the Church. During the next week, I will be away "celebrating" an ordination, First Masses / Masses of Thanksgiving,

and a wedding. Please continue to pray (1) that our parish will continue to be alive in the Spirit and (2) for the increase of vocations.

Mark Nosbush, a seminarian from the Diocese of St. Cloud, has shared, "I experienced a work-related injury right before my 24<sup>th</sup> birthday, which took me off my feet for about six weeks. This gave me time to intentionally pick up the Bible and focus on my faith life. The process was slow, but the Holy Spirit kept pushing me forward. Even as I went back to work, the desire was planted. I came to understand how much God loves me, and this pulled me deeper into my faith. As I followed this path, the Rosary became important in my prayer life."

When I read the lives of the saints, often the turning point in their lives is when they "intentionally" start reading the Bible and the lives of the Saints, which leads them to a relationship with our Blessed Mother, who intercedes for us. At a recent ordination, a man told me that Mary brought him back to the Church after his sister gave him a Marian medal following their father's death.
