

**ASHA HALL OF FAME CRITERIA for PLAYERS**

**The Selection Committee should determine that the individual player under consideration met the following criteria:**

- 1) The individual player nominated must have played minor hockey in Alaska coming up through the various age levels to at least one year of U16's.
- 2) The player must be at least 25 years old. This would set a minimum of being a great USA hockey player, High School hockey player, and junior, college, or pro player.
- 3) The player must have influenced other competitors with his or her performance through any, or all of the following: high performance and skill level, sportsmanship, fair play, competitive techniques and/or persistent and inspirational leadership through their play.
- 4) Was the player ever regarded as a dominant player in their era?
- 5) Did the player have an impact on getting their teams to Nationals in youth hockey, or championships at any level?

**The Selection Committee should consider the following, but it is not essential all of them be met.**

- 1) Did the player display the spirit of the game, during and after their playing career?
- 2) Was the player held in high regard with their teammates during their playing days?
- 3) After their playing career is over, does the player under consideration still have high respect from the hockey community?
