

KAYBC Eligibility and Refunds

Who is eligible to play in KAYBC?

Boys and Girls K-8th grades who live within the boundaries or are open enrolled in the Kimberly Area School District (public schools).

What happens if my player decides they no longer wish to play KAYBC?

KAYBC will only issue a refund if the season has not started (games have not been played). If the season has started, no refunds will be granted. The HOV league and Tournament season are treated as two separate seasons for this purpose.

What happens if a mid-season relocation occurs?

If a player relocates outside of the district AND is no longer open enrolled in the KASD, KAYBC will treat the player as eligible until the end of that season provided the family continues to commit to the practice and game schedules. We recognize that basketball registration is typically late summer to early fall and the ability to register for a new team is highly unlikely. This provision provides the player a continuous experience as they transition homes and schools.

Are there situations where a refund would be granted during the season?

KAYBC will issue a pro-rated refund for the following reasons:

- 1. Player is medically ineligible
- 2. Player experiences a mid-season relocation

For **HOV** League: a pro-rated refund will be issued based on how many weekends played (example: HOV is 3 weekends and 2 weekends have been played – player to receive a prorated refund equal to 1/3 of the fees)

For **Tournament** Season: 50% of the fees will be refunded if the player's season is equal to or less than 50% complete. Beyond that point, no refund will be granted. This also includes the BADL league for 6B-8B. (example: 8 tournaments in the season, and 3 tournaments have passed - the player is eligible for a 50% refund of the fees. If 5 tournaments have passed, the player is not eligible for a refund).

The Board at its sole discretion may approve a refund for a specific extenuating circumstance for reasons not outlined above.
