# **KNLL-RNLL-RWLL Interlock 2023**

### **AAA Division**

Plate Meeting One-Pager

In case of ambiguity, the 2023 KNLL-RNLL-RWLL AAA Interlock rules take precedence over this one-pager.

#### **RULES**

- Base rules are the 2023 Little League Baseball Rulebook.
- 6 inning game, official after 4 innings. Extra innings if necessary to decide the game.
- These optional Little League rules are ON:
  - o Run Rule: 15 runs after 3 innings; 10 runs after 4; 8 runs after 5.
  - Continuous batting order.
  - There is a 5-run limit per inning in every inning before the 6<sup>th</sup>.
  - o Courtesy runners are allowed for the catcher and pitcher of record with 2 outs.
  - o Teams may play with 8 players when 9 players are not available.
- These optional Little League rules are NOT USED:
  - Uncaught 3<sup>rd</sup> strike.
- The infield fly rule applies in all games.
- No pitcher can pitch more than 3 innings per game.

#### **ENCOURAGING BALLS IN PLAY**

- Runners may only steal 1 base per pitch, even if the catcher overthrows.
- "No Stealing Home" -- Scoring Runs: Once the pitcher has the ball and is ready to pitch, runs can only score as a result of obstruction, being forced in, or a batted ball.
- 3 Walk Limit
  - No team may issue more than 3 walks in any one half-inning.
  - If an additional walk is issued, the batter stays in the box, keeps the count, and an
    offensive coach-pitcher finishes that at bat.
  - The player-pitcher begins every new at bat.
  - The umpire calls coach-pitches. The batter can strike out.
  - No runner may advance on a pitch thrown by the coach-pitcher unless forced or the ball is batted.

## **TIME LIMITS**

- All AAA games are played with a time limit:
  - Time limits are tracked by the official scorekeeper.
  - Start time is the time of the actual first pitch (not the scheduled start time).
  - No new inning after 2 hours.
  - No new at bat after 2 hours 15 minutes.
