



2024 Roseville ISI Skate School Ice Show Information



The Roseville Ice Show is an exciting event in which thousands of skaters have participated throughout the past 50+ years. This annual show is a great way for skaters to showcase their learned talents & new skills for family and friends. It is also a rewarding finish to the Winter-Spring skating session. Please consider joining us... more than 80% of skaters enrolled in the Roseville Skate School do!

To participate in the show a skater must be registered in the Winter-Spring Skate School Session.

The last 6 weeks of the Winter-Spring session are devoted to working on routines/group numbers for the ice show. It is during this time that the skate school instructors choreograph the numbers and work with skaters to get them mastered prior to the show. Additionally, after the costumes arrive, pictures are taken, programs are printed, volunteers are set in place... and finally, it's "show time".

Save the date:

- Costume measurement will begin on Saturday, December 2nd and Tuesday, December 5th running through December 16th. Your skater will be measured during their class time. No costume measurements will be taken after December 16, 2023.
- All skaters participating in the show will be charged a fee of \$60 for their costume & ice show fees. Ice show registration form and payment can be submitted on measuring day.
 - The \$60.00 payment covers all costume fees with the exception of accessories such as tights, gloves, etc. The costume will belong to the skater after the show.
 - Skaters not wanting to purchase a costume will be charged \$25 (ice show fees) and expected to wear black bottoms and t-shirt that matches the color of the costumes of the group they will be skating in.
- This year's Roseville Ice Show is April 18, 19 & 20, 2024:

Thursday, April 18, 2024	Performance @ 6.30 p.m.
Friday, April 19, 2024	Performance @ 6:30 p.m.
Saturday, April 20, 2024	Performance @ 3:30 p.m.

As typical each year, the skater will be allowed to miss no more than 2 practices – excused absences that are pre-approved by the skate school coordinator are an exception. Skaters not regularly attending rehearsals will not be able to continue with the show. If any number of absences are planned (ex: Spring Break family vacation, etc.), the coordinator & coach choreographers would appreciate your advance notice.

BASIC SKILLS SKATERS PARTICIPATING IN THE ICE SHOW, PLEASE NOTE

- Skaters enrolled in Tuesday or Saturday Basic Skills lessons and participating in the show will stay at their regularly scheduled class time for ice show rehearsal.
- Tuesday class rehearsals - March 5, 12, 19, 26 & April 2, 9, 2024 – during the Basic skills class time.
- Saturday class rehearsals - March 9, 16, 23, 30 & April 6, 13, 2024 – during the Basic skills class time.
- Finale practice for the first half of the show is Wednesday, April 3, 2024 from 7:00 – 8:30 p.m.
- Finale practice for the second half of the show is Wednesday, April 10, 2024 from 7:00-8:30 p.m.
**** Skaters must be present for their finale practice in order for them to skate in the finale during the ice show.
- Monday, April 15th –
 - 4:30-5:00 – Solo practice
 - 5:00-7:00 – First half ice show
 - 7:00-9:00 – Second half ice show

Dress Rehearsal practice is in costume

- Dress Rehearsal practice for the first half of the show is Tuesday, April 16, 2024, 6:30-8:00 p.m.
- Dress Rehearsal practice for the second half of the show is Wednesday, April 17, 2024, 6:30-8:00 p.m.

FOR SKATERS NOT PARTICIPATING IN THE ICE SHOW:

- All skaters not in the show will continue to have group lessons during your regularly scheduled class time.

PLEASE NOTE

- For Freestyle skaters we will begin costume measuring, Saturday, December 2, 2023 continuing for 3 weeks through December 16, 2023. The freestyle skater will be measured during their class time. Costumes will be ordered the following day; no measurements will be taken after December 16, 2023.
- Freestyle skater's ice show practice time will be different than their class time.
