Varsity Overview

The 2006- 2007 Tiger Wrestling Team had a challenge given to them this season. The challenge – Not to take a back seat to last year's squad and continue the tradition set forth by past Tiger squads. This was not going to be an easy task, considering the loss of 14 seniors from last years team. Last seasons underclassmen made an oath that they were not going to take that back seat, and will continue the wrestling excellence. Many in the wrestling community felt Edwardsville was going to be rebuilding, but the wrestlers and the coaches knew we would just be reloading. This year's varsity squad worked harder in the off-season than any other team, and the results of this showed. This years team only had 8 returning letterman coming back and some of those were part time varsity guys. This years varsity members put in numerous spring and summer matches. Daryl Thomas had 86 matches, Ben Treat 79, Lance Fister 76, Greg Jackson 61, Ethan Knoebel 61, Matt Beasley 52, Bryan Thatch 52, Jared Sawyer 47, Quincy Jackstadt 38 – to name a few. They participated in a weight lifting program that went for March to November. There is no hidden secret to success. The fortunate thing for Edwardsville Wrestling is that our wrestlers know this.

So back to the challenge!! Did this year's team meet the challenge? Yes they did, and then some. We struggled through numerous injuries, throughout the season, but every time somebody new was there to pick up the win. As everybody knows, this team placed in the top 8 of state out of 286 AA schools. That is a great accomplishment. They won the Southwest Conference for the second year in a row, and did not allow Granite City to top them two more consecutive times. No treat was as big as the Sectional Final, where our Tigers fought through adversity and sent Granite home as 2nd. The Tigers were crowned Mascoutah Tournament Champions for a record 4th year in a row. We won a regional championship, and Sectional championship, along with sending 5 wrestlers to the Individual State Tournament. As I reflect back on the season I will always remember the ups and downs that many of our wrestlers had throughout the season, and how they fought adversity, but yet rose to the top. It was a total team effort. It was a definite Tiger Style Campaign.

This year's group of seniors was small, but important. Bryan Thatch and Matt Beasley took control of the team and had great seasons. Kyle Watson came back from an injury after Christmas and helped spark the upper weights. Ryan Reeves helped the squad early, before an unfortunate injury. The other seniors competed hard, and were a great help in the room. I am confident that wrestling will help these young men in their future endeavors. Although every season has ups and down, please use last year's theme in "Remembering the Journey." There has been so many special moments and friendships made, that should last a lifetime. It has been a great ride and you will all be missed greatly. Remember once a Tiger Wrestler, always a Tiger Wrestler.

Filling this year's group of seniors will be difficult, but unlike last year we have a large nucleus of returning letterman. We will be returning 4 state qualifiers from 2007, along with 2006 state qualifier Chad Lunn. This is a great nucleus of talent when you include the numerous sectional qualifiers returning. Let's understand that this does not mean instant success and we must not rest on our laurels. We need to continue to do what got us to where we are today, the off-season starts soon. Weight lifting and spring/summer wrestling will be available to all. If you are playing another sport, we support that and good luck. If you are not, be ready and committed. Underclassmen – meet the new challenge of surpassing this years accomplishments. As the seniors and coaches know, the sky could be the limit next year.

Seniors – congratulations on a great career. Coaches, thanks for being the best staff around. Junior Varsity Overview

The Junior Varsity team had a fantastic 2006-2007 campaign. This year's team consisted of seven sophomores and eleven juniors. After a tough loss to a very good Northwest, MO. team 48-36 the team finished strong with ten straight wins bringing our season dual meet record to 20-1. As the bad weather came our varsity team was forced to pick up another tournament so we had the junior varsity team fill in for them in a scheduled quad meet up north. Although we lost each of the three meets our team competed very hard and gained very valuable experience for the future of our program.

The junior varsity team competed in four tournaments taking third place in the Lafayette Tournament and first place in the Southwest Conference Tournament (pool A). The Collinsville Tournament and our J.V. Tournament did not keep team points. A number of our wrestlers placed high in each of the four tournaments.

Coaches, I would like to thank you all (high school, middle school, EWC) for everything you do that makes Edwardsville Wrestling the best program around. Thanks EWC Boosters and parents for your support in the program and your sons. Wrestlers thanks for all the hard work, dedication and great memories. I wish you all the best senior class of 2007.
