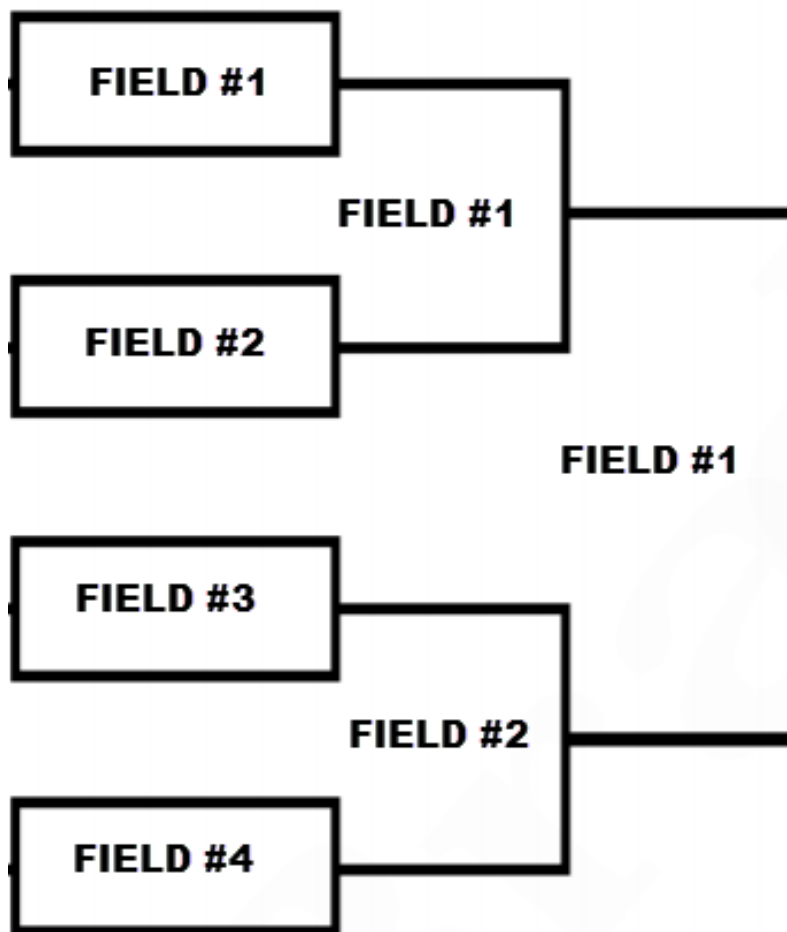

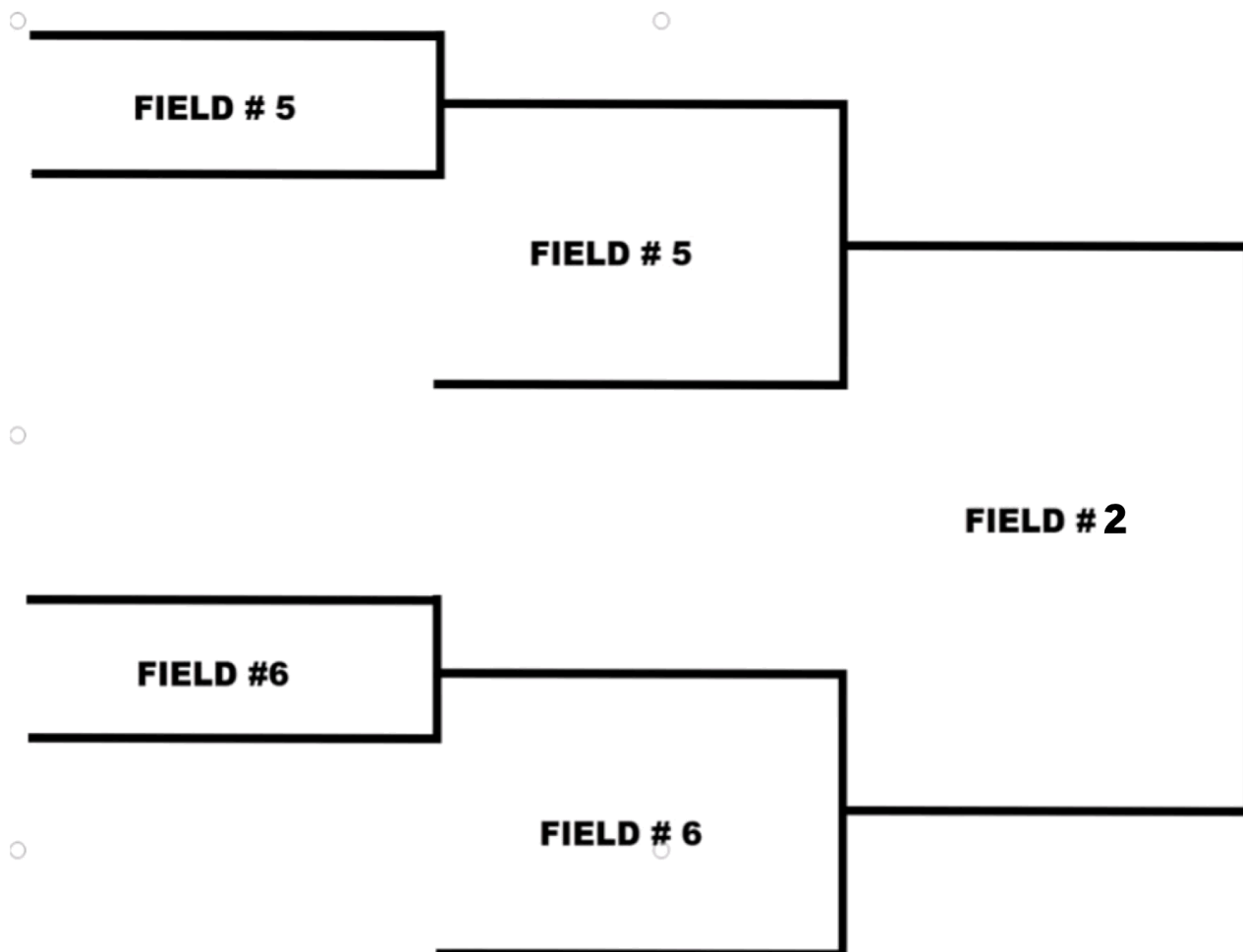

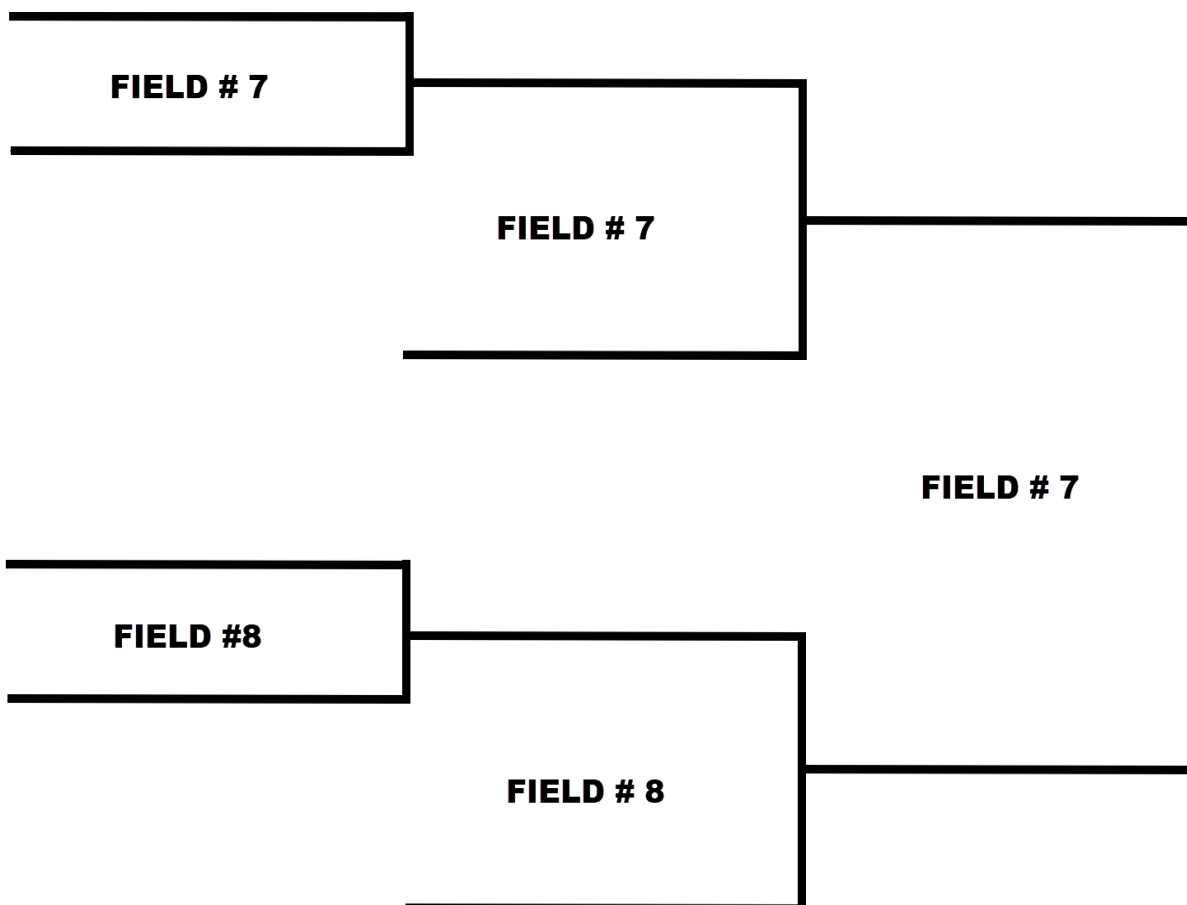

LINEMAN COMPETITION EVENTS

General Rules:

Each team will be given 12 wristbands to place on 12 linemen competitors. Only athletes with a wristband will be allowed to compete!! If an athlete is not present when the event starts, we will not wait for them, another athlete will need to take their place. Each event will require the participation of either 8, 10 or 12 athletes. The number of athletes in each event is in parenthesis below.

1. Bench Press- (8) Each athlete will bench press 205 lbs. as many reps as possible. The athletes will get a chance to warm up and then one attempt only will be recorded. The spotter may only help the bencher with the bar off the rack. Any touching of the bar after that point from the spotter will end the attempt. **8 competitors will compete!**
2. Power Clean Max- (8) Each athlete will get 3 attempts to Power Clean the most weight they can for 1 Rep. The athletes will be able to warm up in the warm-up area. Once the athlete is warm, they will be given 3 attempts and the best Power Clean will be recorded. The athlete must control the weight at the top until the judge says they are good. There is also no bouncing of the weight off the ground. Each Power Clean must start from the ground. **8 competitors will compete!**
3. Tire Flip Relay- (8) Each athlete will be asked to flip the tire 4 times each. Between each flip the athlete will be asked to run around the tire one full circle before the next flip is conducted. After the 4th flip the athlete will tag the next competitor and will NOT run around the tire. **8 competitors will compete!**
4. 2-Man Sled Relay- (8) In teams of two, the athletes will push the two-man sled around the trash can course. Just like NASCAR, they will be making a series of left-hand turns. When they return to the starting point, the next two- man team will take over and push the sled through the course. When the last two-man team finishes the time will stop. Any trash can that is hit will result in a 2-second penalty. If the sled travels inside of the course, a 2 second penalty will be enforced. **8 competitors will compete!**
5. 6-Man Bob Sled Relay- (12) In teams of 6 the sled will be pushed 50 yards. When the back of the sled passes the 50- yard mark, the new team of 6 competitors will push the sled back 50 yards to the starting point. No need to turn the sled. Any violation of these stipulations will result in a 2-second penalty. **12 competitors will compete!**
6. Obstacle Course- (8) Each competitor will begin the obstacle course by pushing a 1-man sled 5 yards. Each athlete must turn the sled around for the returning athlete. If the entire sled does not clear the line a 2-second penalty will be enforced. After the entire sled has cleared the 5-yard mark, the athlete will move on and flip a monster tire 1 time. If the athlete is unable to flip the tire a 5-second penalty will be enforced. The athlete will then run a slalom course of pop-up bags making sure to go around the outside of each bag. If the athlete cuts a corner a 5- second penalty will be enforced. The athlete will then push the Prowler straight ahead for 10 yards. If the back of the Prowler does not clear the line a 2-second penalty will be enforced. The athlete will then shuffle through 4 Agility bags and sprint to the finish, tagging the next athlete. Any purposeful attempt to skip a part of the obstacle course will result in a disqualification of the entire team and no points will be awarded. **8 competitors will participate!**

7. Tug-O-War Single Elimination Tournament to Finish: (10)
- a. Teams will be placed in brackets based on point accumulation from the day's events.
 - b. Gloves are allowed.
 - c. There is absolutely no wrapping of the rope around the arm or any other part of the body. The team will be disqualified if it happens.
 - d. **10 competitors will participate!**



PASSING TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

SEEDING RULES

The first (1st) and second (2nd) place teams from each pool will play in the Gold Division Championship Playoff Bracket. The remaining third (3rd), fourth (4th), and fifth (5th) place teams from each pool will be placed into the Silver & Bronze Division Playoff Brackets, with the bottom team from each pool going to the Bronze bracket.

All other teams shall be separated by point differential. If there is a tie, seeding will be determined by points scored first. If a tie still exists, seeding will be by points allowed. If there is still a tie, then a coin flip will determine the final seeding.

TOURNAMENT PLAY RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Each team will be guaranteed a total of (5) games. Every player must wear a soft -shell helmet
2. All High School Football rules apply where they are needed.
3. One hand touch below the neck.
4. No Blocking.
5. All fumbles that touch the ground are dead, except during the center to quarterback exchange, in which case the quarterback may continue the play.
6. Play is limited to 7-on-7. Any team with an eight-man front must put one down on a knee BEFORE the ball is snapped and must be at the line of scrimmage, between the tackles (the man on a knee may change with motion). Failure to do so will result in the offense having a choice of keeping the result of a play or taking the play over. The eighth man MAY NOT jam or make contact with an offensive player.
7. The offense will receive 3.0 seconds to throw without a center and 3.59 seconds if a center is used. If the QB throws the football from 3 yards or less from the line of scrimmage the offense will only have 2.5 seconds to throw the football.
8. There are NO EMPTY sets. Single backs can line up no wider than the regular tackle position. If the back goes out on a pass, he **MAY** release **INSIDE** the tackle position, but the RB can go no more than 10 yards downfield. If the RB releases outside the tackle box, there is no limit on them. In other words, double smash - RB down the pipe is not allowed but a wheel up the sideline is!
9. Coaches must stay out of the defensive secondary.
10. Any flagrant foul or fight may result in either player and/or team being disqualified.
11. The first series will begin on the plus 40-yard line. You need to go 40 yards to score.
12. There is a 30-second count to run the play. (5-yard Penalty and the clock stops) In the last 2 minutes
13. Each team is allowed one draw per game. No draw plays are allowed from the 20-yard line in. No QB draws.
14. Each team has three downs to get past the 20-yard line. The offense has four downs to score inside the 20-yard line.
15. If the defense stops the offense on downs, the defensive team then takes over on offense at the plus 40-yard line. If an Interception occurs the Offense will get the ball at the 30-yard line. An interception will count as 1 point.
16. A touchdown is worth 6 points. The extra point is automatic, however, if you choose to go for 2, the try will occur from the 10-yard line. If the 2-point effort fails, then the touchdown will revert back to 6 points only.
17. All games are 30 minutes long. However, a game will continue past the game time limit if the offensive team has a chance to win or tie. The team must get to the 20-yard



line (make a first down) before the game time runs out in order to finish the drive.

18. In the event of a tie score, each team will get **ONE** play from the 40-yard line. Whichever team gains more yards on that one play will win the game. No draw plays will be allowed in overtime. An interception in overtime wins the game. If both teams end with the same result, then a second overtime will be played.
19. A sack (time to throw the ball expired) results in a loss of 5 yards from the previous spot. A sack will **NOT** overrule an interception! You throw a pic, you throw a pic!!
20. If a penalty occurs from the 40-yard line of scrimmage, the penalty or loss will be marked off on the offensive team's next positive gain. In other words, we will "bank" 5 yards.

South County Classic Penalties

1. All penalties will be enforced. Emphasis is placed on pass interference, holding, unnecessary roughness, and unsportsmanlike conduct.
2. No blocking, or screening of opponents.
3. Press coverage and jamming will be refereed in accordance with HS football rules.
4. False Start will result in a 5 yard penalty and replay the down.
5. Offensive Pass Interference: 5 yard penalty and a loss of down.
6. Delay of Game: In the last 2 minutes of a game the clock will be stopped.
7. Unsportsmanlike Conduct: 15-yard penalty, and possible ejection.
8. Individual Fight: Automatic Player Ejection / Team Fight: Automatic Team Disqualification

Defensive Penalties:

All defensive penalties will result back to high school rules. For example, Defensive Pass Interference will not result in an automatic first down. The yardage will be marked off and if a first down is earned then a first down will be awarded.
